ORDER

Heard both sides.

This petition is filed U/S.439(A) of Cr.P.C to relax the existing condition passed on 30.01.2024 in CrI.M.P.No.650/2024 regarding the Petitioner/Accused by this Court that the Petitioner/Accused was directed to appear before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.30 A.M. until further Orders.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused contended that the Petitioner/Accused is obeying the condition from 01.02.2024 till date without fail and he feels that it is very difficult to obey the condition, because he is the sole bread winner of his family. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

Notice was ordered to the Learned Public Prosecutor and he has appeared before this Court and contended that the Petitioner/Accused is obeying the daily condition for 42 days and suitable orders may be passed.

Hence, on considering the representations made above, this Court is modified the earlier conditions imposed as **“the Petitioner/Accused is directed to appear before the Respondent Police Station on every Thursday at 10.30 A.M. until further orders”** instead of daily.

Hence, this petition is allowed accordingly.
