## **ORDER**

This petition is filed U/S.483(1)(b) of BNSS to relax the existing condition passed on 25.10.2024 in Crl.M.P.No.7110/2024 for the offences u/secs.8(c), 20(b)(ii)(A) of NDPS Act regarding the Petitioner/Accused by this Court that the Petitioner/Accused was directed to appear before the Respondent Police on every Monday at 10.30 A.M. until further Orders.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused stated that the Petitioner/Accused is obeying the condition without fail. He feels that it is very difficult to obey the condition, because he is the sole bread winner of his family. Hence, he prays to allow the petition.

The Learned Public Prosecutor has contended that the Petitioner/Accused is obeying the weekly condition for 4 Weeks and the investigation is pending and suitable orders may be passed.

In such circumstances, considering the nature of offences, this court is modified the earlier conditions imposed as "the Petitioner/Accused is directed to appear before the SHO, Respondent Police Station on every 1<sup>st</sup> day of English Calendar month until further orders" instead of Weekly.

Hence this petition is allowed accordingly.
