E-FILING OF CASES

The Hon'ble High Court of Madras, upon approval of the Hon'ble The Chief Justice had proposed to initiate the facility of mandatory e-filing of cases to the Courts dealing with the cases arising under Sec.138 of Negotiable Instruments (NI) Act and to the Courts dealing with Criminal Appeals and Criminal Revisions and allied matters arising in Cheque Bounce cases in the District Judiciary which will commence on and from 17.07.2023.

Accordingly, this court notifies the e-filing of cases which is made mandatory initially to the Courts dealing with cases arising under Sec.138 of Negotiable Instruments Act in the District Judiciary on the e-filing portal (i.e., <https://efiling.ecourts.gov.in>) developed by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India which will commence on and from 17.07.2023. The detailed guidelines and tutorial video prepared by the Madras High Court for the e-filing process and the detailed user manual prepared by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India along with the steps required to be taken as per the existing practice of the Madras High Court, are available in the website of Madras High Court.
