In supersession of the notification dt.31.12.2022, applications are invited from the suitable and eligible candidates for appointment to the post of **President, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Hyderabad in the State of Telangana** in terms of section 43 of Consumer Protection Act, 2019 read with Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 against the vacancy arisen due to retirement w.e.f.5.2.2023.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

In terms of Rule-3 (1) of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020, the applicant shall not be qualified for appointment as President of State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, unless he is, or has been, a Judge of the High Court.

2. PROCEDURE OF APPOINTMENT:

Appointments will be made by the State Government in consultation with and in concurrence with the Hon'ble Chief Justice, High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad.

3. TERM OF OFFICE:

The President of the State Commission shall hold office for a term of four years or up to the age of sixty-seven years, whichever is earlier and shall be eligible for reappointment for another term of four years subject to the age limit of sixty-seven years.

4. SALARY AND ALLOWANCES:

The salary and allowances of the President of the State Commission shall be as per the Consumer Protection (Salary, allowance and Conditions of Service of President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 shown below and/or related orders/ Notifications to be issued under the said Rules from time to time by the State of Telangana.

Category of post	Salary and allowances
President of the State Commission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The President of the State Commission shall receive the salary and other allowances as are admissible to a sitting judge of the High Court of the State. • The pay of a person appointed as President or Member, who is in receipt of any pension, shall be reduced by the gross amount of pension drawn by him.

5. DISQUALIFICATIONS:

A person shall be disqualified for appointment as the President of a State Commission, if he-

- a) has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which involves moral turpitude; or
- b) has been adjudged to be insolvent; or
- c) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- d) has been removed or dismissed from the service of the State Government or Central Government or a body corporate owned or controlled by such Government; or
- e) has, in the opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest as is likely to prejudicially affect his functions as the President.

6. REMOVAL:

The State Government shall remove from office any President, who-

- (a) has been adjudged as an insolvent; or
- (b) has been convicted of an offence which involves moral turpitude; or
- (c) has become physically or mentally incapable of acting as such member; or
- (d) has acquired such financial or other interest as is likely to affect prejudicially his functions as a member; or
- (e) has so abused his position as to render his continuance in office prejudicial to public interest;

Provided that where a President is proposed to be removed on any ground specified in clauses (c) to (e) of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020, the President shall be informed of the charges against him and given an opportunity of being heard in respect of those charges.

7. CERTIFICATE OF PHYSICAL FITNESS: -

The candidates selected for appointment to the above posts, will be required to produce a Certificate of Physical Fitness from the competent authority not below the rank of Civil Surgeon/District Medical Officer.

8. OATHS OF OFFICE AND SECRECY:

Every person appointed to be the President shall, before entering upon his office, make and subscribe an oath of office in **Form-I** and oath of secrecy in **Form-II** annexed hereto.

Application (in original) in prescribed form along with attested photocopies of supporting documents regarding age, education, experience etc., should be reached to the Registrar(FAC), State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission for the State of Telangana, Eruvaka Building, Opp. Sridhar Function Hall, Khairatabad, Hyderabad-500004, **on or before 05.05.2025 by 5.00 PM.**

Sub: - Selection for the post of Judicial Member in Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT), Mumbai – Reg.

Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT) is a statutory body established under the Securities and Exchange Board of India Act, 1992 to hear and dispose of appeals against orders passed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India, the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) constituted under the PFRDA Act, 2013, Insurance Regulatory Development Authority of India (IRDAI) constituted under the Insurance Act, 1938, the General Insurance Business (Nationalization) Act, 1972 and the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority Act, 1999 and the Rules and Regulations framed thereunder. The SAT is located at Mumbai, and the Judicial Member, upon selection, will be posted at Mumbai.

2. Applications are being invited for one post of Judicial Member, SAT, Mumbai.
3. The qualifications, eligibility, salary and other terms and conditions of the appointment of a candidate for the post of Judicial Member will be governed by the provisions of the Tribunal (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021 and Tribunals Reforms Act, 2021.
4. As per rule 3 (7) (b) of the Tribunal (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021, a person shall not be qualified for appointment as Judicial Member of Securities Appellate Tribunal, unless he, —
 - i. is, or has been, a Judge of a High Court; or
 - ii. has been an advocate for ten years with substantial experience in litigation in matters relating to financial sector before Securities Exchange Board of India, Securities Appellate Tribunal, High Court or Supreme Court

4.1. As per other provisions of Tribunal (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021:

i. the Judicial Member of the SAT shall be a person who does not have any financial or other interests as are likely to prejudicially affect their functions as such member.

ii. the appointment of the Judicial Member shall be done after issuance of a Certificate of Medical Fitness by an authority specified by the Central Government in this behalf.

iii. the Judicial Member shall be paid a salary of Rs. Two Lakh Twenty-Five Thousand (fixed) per month. In case the person appointed as Judicial Member is in receipt of any pension, the pay of such person shall be reduced by the gross amount of pension drawn by him.

iv. the Judicial Member shall be entitled to draw allowances and benefits as are admissible to a Government of India officer holding Group 'A' post carrying the same pay. The Judicial Member shall have the option to avail of accommodation to be provided by the Central Government as per the rules for the time being in force or shall be eligible for reimbursement of house rent subject to a limit of Rs. one lakh twenty-five thousand per month.

v. the Judicial Member shall be entitled to the facility of staff car for journeys for official and private purposes in accordance with the facilities as are admissible to a Government of India officer holding Group 'A' post carrying the same pay as per provisions of Staff Car Rules.

5. As per provisions under section 3 (1) of the Tribunals Reforms Act, 2021, a person who has not completed the age of 50 years as on the last date for submission of applications, shall not be eligible for appointment as a Judicial Member.

5.1. As per provisions under section 5 (i) of the Tribunals Reforms Act, 2021, the Judicial Member of a Tribunal shall hold office for a term of four (4) years or till he attains the age of sixty-seven years, whichever is earlier.

6. The Search-Cum-Selection Committee constituted under the Tribunal Reforms Act 2021 for recommending names for appointment to the said post shall scrutinize the applications with respect to suitability of application for the posts by giving due weightage to qualification and experience of candidates and shortlist candidates for conducting personal interaction. The final selection will be done on the basis of overall evaluation of candidates done by the Committee based on the qualification, experience and personal interaction.



- (1.1) The Members of the State Commission shall be persons of ability, integrity and standing who have adequate knowledge of, and have shown capacity in, dealing with problems relating to engineering, finance, commerce, economics, law or management.
- (1.2) The Member of the State Commission shall not hold any other office.

Additional and essential requirement for Member (Law) :

A person who is or has been holding a post of High Court Judge or District Judge or possessing requisite qualification to have been appointed as a judge of High Court or a District Judge.

- 2/ **Tenure :-** As per section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003 The Members so appointed shall hold the post for a term of 5 years from the date on which he/she enters upon office or till he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier.
- 3/ **Pay :-** The Members shall be entitled to pay level of 15 of 7th pay scale notified by Government of India plus other allowance as notified by State Government.

If the incumbent draws pension, then he/she will be entitled to get the pay after deduction of the pension amount. The person so appointed shall not hold any other office. He/she shall have to resign or opt for voluntary retirement from the existing service, if any, to which he belongs, in case he has not attained the age of superannuation.
