Sub: eCourts project – eFiling facility already been implemented in all the Courts of Perambalur District – further directions issued-Notification - Reg.

The eFiling facility has been successfully migrated and implemented in all the courts of Perambalur District from the e-Filing 1.0 version to the e-Filing 3.0 version with several features.

As of now, the police, GP, PP, APP, etc. are submitting their replies to the concerned courts through email. The email mode of submitting any case-related documents is stopped immediately, and the court should not be accepting any case-related documents through email from now onwards.

e-Filing 1.0 version, in criminal cases, police documents and government pleadings, public prosecutors, and additional public prosecutors or police investigation reports were submitted to the court through email (by scanned documents) or submitted a physical copy, and then the concerned court uploaded the received and scanned documents to the CIS software's "index register" manually.

After the e-Filing 3.0 version migration, the police, GP, PP, APP, party-in-person, etc. can directly submit all kinds of **case-related documents** through the e-Filing web portal based on the CIS-generated case CNR number and case registration number, and they **must be uploaded (in PDF text searchable format) and indexed**, and then they will be automatically replicated in CIS software.

Therefore, each police station, investigation agency, party-in-person, government pleaders, public prosecutors, additional public prosecutors, etc. have to create and register a separate user ID for themselves to handle their related cases in respective courts.

From today onwards, the above-mentioned users, police officials, and public litigants are mandatory to submit their case-related replies, opinions, or any supporting documents to the courts using their official e-filing user ID.

This will be strictly followed without any deviations.
