The appointment of the individual is pending verification of her antecedents by the concerned police, if any adverse remarks reported in the verification of antecedents, her provisional selection to the post shall be reviewed and if necessary the Hon'ble High Court may substitute the candidate with next meritorious candidate by following the rule of reservation or may carry forward the post to the next recruitment.
