ORDER:

In the Pudukkottai Head Quarters there are three Magistrate courts are functioning. The Judicial Magistrate No.II Court and Additional Mahila Court are the newly constituted court. Before the constitution of the Judicial Magistrate No.II Court and Additional Mahila Court, the Judicial Magistrate, Pudukkottai was the only magistrate to attend the Dying Declaration duty for the whole year. Now totally three Judicial Magistrate courts are functioning in the Pudukkottai Head Quarters. Hence the Dying Declaration duty has allocated to all three Judicial Magistrates. As stated below, the Judicial Magistrates are nominated to attend Dying Declaration Duty.

The Dying Declaration duty is allocated as follows.

Sl.No.	Name of the Officer	Period for the Dying Declaration Work
1	The Judicial Magistrate No.I, Pudukkottai.	1 st day to 10 th day of every month.
2	The Judicial Magistrate No.II, Pudukkottai.	11 th day to 20 th day of every month.
3	The Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Pudukkottai.	21 st day to month end.

Hence, the Judicial Officers in the Head Quarters are directed to attend the Dying Declaration duty for the above period in every month.
