e-Courts Project – Migration and Implementation of e-Filing 3.0 Version in the Judicature of Madras High Court and in the District Judiciary – Requested to take necessary action – Regarding.

With reference to the subject, I am to state that as directed by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India, the Registry has proposed to migrate e-Filing 1.0 version to e-Filing 3.0 version in the Judicature of Madras High Court and in the District Judiciary, which is having many features and much faster than the e-Filing 1.0 version. The Notification regarding the same will be hosted in the Official Website of Madras High Court.

I am further to state that the pending cases for scrutiny in e-filing 1.0 are to be assigned with CNR number, before the commencement of migration process. Unless the pending cases for scrutiny are not cleared, there is possibility of loss of data in e-filing 1.0.

In this regard, I am directed to request your goodselves to give the following instructions to all concerned towards migration of e-Filing 3.0 version :

- i) to accept urgent anticipatory bail applications and cases nearing expiry of limitation, if any, through physical filing during the migration period.
- ii) to request all the Advocates to represent their cases which are in objection stage in e-Filing 1.0 on or before 28.09.2023, to avoid loss of data during the migration process.
- iii) to the staff concerned to accept the pending cases in e-filing 1.0 and to assign with CNR number on or before 29.09.2023 (3 p.m), since the cases without the CNR number will not reflect during the migration process.
 - iv) to host Notification in the District Court Website and to sensitize the Advocates towards migration of e-filing 3.0 facility.
