It is hereby brought to the notice of the Members of the Bar that in addition to the First week after the Summer Vacation, 2015 viz. If it is found that Fresh matters registered upto 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2015 cannot be listed between 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 to 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2015 and 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 to 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2015, the remaining Fresh Matters alongwith the Fresh Matters registered from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 to 07<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 will be listed in such a manner that besides the Fresh Matters to be listed on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 and 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 (Miscellaneous Days) not more than 20 Fresh Matters will also be listed on Non-Miscellaneous Days viz. 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 and 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 in chronological order of registration in addition to Regular Matters.
