SUPREME COURT OF INDIA SIGNS MOU WITH IT MADRAS

Supreme Court of India under the leadership of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India Dr. Justice D.Y. The collaboration which will also also focus to leverage Al Tools in Capacity Building & Training, creating e-Learning Platform and ICT skill development courses, is a significant leap forward in the incorporation of artificial intelligence (Al) and technology to enhance the efficiency, accessibility and capacity building of the legal domain. The MoU is aimed to facilitate the digital transformation of the Indian judiciary, aligning it with the vision for a more efficient and technologically advanced legal ecosystem to improve access to justice.
