In substitution of the earlier notice dated 10 June 2024, the modalities regarding the Advocates-on-Record Examination, are set out below:

- 1. Candidates who appeared through the pen and paper mode for Paper-I (Practice and Procedure of the Supreme Court) of the Advocates-on-Record Examination held on 10 June 2024 shall be assessed on the basis of the answer sheets submitted by them;
- 2. (a) A fresh examination for Paper-I will be held after the reopening of the Court after the summer recess for candidates who had submitted their options for the Computer Based Test (CBT). The date of the examination shall be notified in due course;
 - (b) Such of the above candidates who desire to appear for the fresh examination in Paper-I will have to submit an option to appear again for Paper-I;
 - (c) In that case only the marks secured in the fresh examination for Paper-I will be taken into consideration;
 - (d) Candidates who do not submit their options for the fresh examination in Paper-I will be graded on the basis of the answers submitted at the CBT held on 10 June 2024; and
 - (e) The last date for submission of options to take the fresh examination in Paper-I will be 30 June 2024. Options must be submitted on advocate-on-record@sci.nic.in mentioning the name of the candidate, cell phone number and roll number allotted to the candidate for the present examination.
- 3. All candidates who have registered for the AoR Examination currently under process (including those who had opted for a computer-based examination) will have to appear for the papers scheduled on 11, 14 and 15 June 2024 in the pen and paper mode only;

- 4. Considering the interest of the candidates, the duration of the examination papers scheduled on 11, 14 and 15 June 2024 has been increased by one hour;
- 5. The examination for the papers scheduled on 11, 14 and 15 June 2024 will be conducted between 11am and 3pm for all candidates; and
- 6. The venue for all the remaining papers will be the Judges' Library on the ground floor of the Additional Building Complex of the Supreme Court of India.
