

- Idu'l Fitr, Muharram/Mahavir Jayanti fall on 9th January and 16th April, 2000 respectively which are Sundays and they have not been shown separately.
- Buddha Purnima and Milad-un-Nabi fall on 18th May and 15th June, 2000 respectively which are closed days during the Summer Vacation and the Registry will also remain closed on these two days.
- 4. The Summer Vacation of the Court will commence on Monday the 15th May, 2000 and the Court will resume its sitting on Monday the 10th July, 2000. The Summer Vacation is shaded in Red. The Registry of the court will, however, be functioning throughout the vacation except on Saturdays Sundays and Holidays. However, the Registry of the Court will remain open on last Saturday of the Summer Vacation i.e., 8th July, 2000.
- 5. Idu'l Fitr, falls twice on 9th January and 28th December and Idu'l zuha, Muharram and Milad-ul-Nabi which fall on 17th March, 16th April and 15th June, 2000 respectively are subject to change depending upon the visibility of the Moon. If the Government of India declare any change in these dates through TV/AIR/Newspaper the same will be followed.
- During the Christmas Holidays, the Registry will remain closed from 25th December, 2000 to 1st January, 2001. (Both days inclusive)
