1. Online tenders are invited through Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP), from **Delhi/NCR region** based authorised dealers for awarding the Rate Contract for supply & installation of UPS Batteries (Exide or reputed Brand make) of different specifications which are provided at the Residential Office of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India, Hon'ble Judges and in the Supreme Court Registry for a period of two years as per details given hereinbelow. The batteries of the UPSs are to be replaced at the sites where they are presently provided. The details of various UPS are given herein below in Tables 'A'.

The Tenderers/Firms are required to quote their lowest/ best rates and are advised to follow the instructions “Instructions To Bidder for Online Bid Submission” as mentioned in this document and also in 'Downloads' (Sl. No. 20) section of online submission of bids of CPP Portal.

4. The interested tenderers/ firms are expected to examine online all the instructions, terms and conditions and specifications in the tender documents. Failing to furnish all information required in the tender document in every respect will be at the tenderer's risk and may result in rejection of the tender. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

5. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or

tenderers having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or husband and wife or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to be rejected.

6. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from the Supreme Court of India website i.e. <https://www.sci.gov.in/notice-category/tenders> and Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website i.e. <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) would be forfeited and tenderer will be liable to be banned from doing business with Supreme Court of India.

A. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TENDER

7. The tenderers are required to quote their lowest rates as per **Annexure-'B'** enclosed herewith. The tenderers are to quote rates per unit **under buy-back** with minimum 2 years guarantee/warranty for supply & installation of UPS Batteries (Exide or reputed Brand make) with discount on bulk purchase, if any, and percentage of GST, which should be valid for a period of two years from the date of awarding the contract.

8. The Registry is not bound to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject or accept any or all the tenders, partly or completely, at any

time, without assigning any reason thereof.

9. Tenderers/ firms are required to provide Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in form of Demand Draft (DD) of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only). The original EMD in the form of Demand Draft (to be made on or after publication date of this tender) must be submitted in a sealed envelope superscribing the title of this NIT addressed to Assistant Registrar (AM), Supreme Court of India, at the Counter No. 2 (E-Sewa Kendra), Supreme Court of India, Main Building, well before the due date and time of bid submission (as mentioned on the Critical Date Sheet at Page No. 2 of this NIT). **However, in case of bidders having MSME Certificate, the same is to be submitted on-line for claiming exemption from submitting EMD, as per critical Date sheet.**

10. The tenderers are required to provide Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Registrar, Supreme Court of India". All the applicable bank charges shall be borne by the applicant and he shall not have any claim whatsoever on this account on the Registry and no interest will be payable on Earnest Money Deposit (EMD). In case of re- tendering, the firms which have submitted the Demand Draft in earlier calls will be required to submit Demand Draft along with their tender/application in subsequent calls also.

11. **Tender not accompanied with the EMD/ Exemption Certificate is liable to be rejected.**

12. Each tenderer has to sign and submit the attached **Tender Acceptance Letter as per Annexure - 'C'.**

13. Bids will be opened as per date/time as mentioned in the Tender Critical Date Sheet.
14. The Registry, in its discretion, reserves the right to reject or accept any or all tenders, partly or completely, at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
15. Each tenderer has to certify that all the terms and conditions are acceptable to them. The Earnest Money Deposit/ Security Deposit shall stand forfeited in case of breach of any of the condition mentioned herein.
16. Hypothetical or conditional Tender will not be entertained. Tender once submitted shall not be allowed to be withdrawn or altered. If the tender is withdrawn or altered by the concerned party at any time after it is submitted, appropriate action will be taken, which may include confiscation of EMD/Performance Security or/and also debarring the tenderer for future participation.
17. The Registry will deal with the tenderer directly and no middlemen or commission agents etc. should be approached by the tenderer to represent the cause and they will not be entertained by the Registry.
18. The Registry reserves the right to make any change, at any time, in the terms and conditions of the Notice Inviting Tender and accept or reject any or all tenders wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof.

B. SUBMISSION OF TENDER

19. The tender shall be submitted online in two (2) parts, viz., Technical Bid and Price Bid.

20. All the pages of bid being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the tenderer, irrespective of nature of content of the documents before uploading and tenderer will submit signed Tender Acceptance Letter annexed as '**Annexure- 'C'**'

21. Technical Bid

C. TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE SUCCESSFUL TENDERER

23. The successful tenderer shall have to deposit **Performance Security Deposit** @ 5% of the total value of the contract by way of Demand Draft/Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of "The Registrar (Admn.), Supreme Court of India, New Delhi" within a week of the receipt of the work order which will be refunded after 60 days from the date of successful completion of contract or payment of the last bill whichever is later.
24. The successful tenderer shall undertake/ensure that the character and antecedents of each individual employee deployed by them have been got verified by the Police Authorities and record be maintained to this effect and further shall be verified from time to time.
25. The rates so quoted should be valid for a period of **Two Years** from the date of awarding of contract, as the UPS Batteries will be required to be replaced at different intervals during the Contractual Period as and when required. Rates quoted shall include costs of commuting, installation of batteries etc. and no separate travelling charges shall be admissible.
26. The UPS Batteries should be supplied strictly as per the specifications, which will be inspected by an Inspection Committee comprising of Senior Officers of the Registry and in case the supply is not found strictly in conformity with the approved specifications, the same will be liable to be rejected and the entire supply will have to be replaced with the quality exactly commensurate with the approved specifications at the cost of the tenderer. The decision of the Inspection Committee in this regard shall be final.

D. PENALTIES

27. Even after awarding of the Contract to the successful tenderer, the Registry reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time during the subsistence of contract in case of breach of any conditions or deficiency in service and to entrust the work to another dealer/vendor and to recover the loss, if any, sustained by the Registry from the tenderer.

28. The work executed by the firm should be to the satisfaction of the concerned officer where work has to be executed. If the same is not found satisfactory, the firm will have to do the job again at its own cost. The decision of the concerned officer and of the Registry in this regard will be final and unassailable and binding on the tenderer.

29. Irrespective of the fact as to whether the Registry gets the job done or purchased the batteries from outside, the Registry may impose a penalty of 1% of total cost. Further, any loss/damage sustained to the Registry's UPSs will be recovered from the successful tenderer.

30. If the job is not done within stipulated period and the Registry is forced to get it done from open market at higher rates, the tenderer will have to make payment of the loss caused to the Registry.

31. In case of default of any conditions stated hereinabove by the successful tenderer during the period of their contract, the performance security deposit shall stand forfeited without any further notice or opportunity.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

REGISTRATION

- 1) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link “Online bidder Enrollment” on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- 2) As part of the enrollment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.

2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / email in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.

3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.

2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.

3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders

can use “My Space” or “Other Important Documents” area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the “My Space” area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

Note: My Documents space is only a repository given to the Bidders to ease the uploading process. If Bidder has uploaded his Documents in My Documents space, this does not automatically ensure these Documents being part of Technical Bid.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 2) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 3) Bidder has to select the payment option as “offline” to pay the tender fee / EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument.
- 4) Bidder should prepare the EMD as per the instructions specified in the tender document. The original should be posted/couriered/given in person to the concerned official, latest by the last date of bid submission or as specified in the tender documents. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- 5) Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

6) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.

7) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid opener's public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

8) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

9) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.

10) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS

1) Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person indicated in the tender.
