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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating

to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.

3. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

A. Instruction to the Bidders

- Hypothetical / Conditional bids shall not be entertained. Bid once submitted shall not be allowed to be withdrawn or altered. If the bid is withdrawn or altered by the concerned party at any time after it is submitted, the bidder may be debarred to participate in the bidding process of the Supreme Court of India
- The bidders are expected to examine all the instructions online, terms and conditions and specifications in the tender document. Failing to furnish all information required by the tender document in any respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in the rejections of the tender.
- The rates should be valid for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids. The bidder shall not be entitled during the said period of 90 days to revoke or cancel its bid or to vary the bid or any terms thereof.
- The Registry will deal with the bidder directly and no middle-men/ agents/ commission agents etc. should be asked by the bidder to represent their cause and they shall not be entertained by the Registry. The bid form is not transferable and the agency shall not be permitted to transfer their rights and obligations to any other person/ organization or otherwise.
- The Registry, in its discretion, reserves the right to make any change, at any time, in the terms and conditions of the bid and reject or accept any or all the bids, wholly or partly, without assigning any reason thereof.

6. The bidder shall give an undertaking (as per Annexure A) that the Firm/Partners/Director/Proprietor has not been blacklisted and its business dealings with Central/ State Government/ Public Sector units/ Autonomous bodies have not been banned/terminated on the account of poor performance.
7. Each bidder has to certify that all the terms and conditions including additional terms and conditions are acceptable to him/her.
8. Bid once submitted shall not be allowed to be withdrawn till finalization of the matter.
9. The Registry is not bound to accept the rates submitted by the lowest bidder or any other Bidder nor does it undertake to assign any reasons for its decision in this matter.

B. PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUCCESSFUL BIDDER

1. The bidder should specifically state whether rates are inclusive of GST (as applicable) and if the same are not stated, it will be deemed that the rates are inclusive of GST.
2. The material supplied will be inspected by an Inspection Committee comprising of Senior Officers of the Registry and in case the supply is not found strictly in conformity with the approved samples/ specifications, the same will be liable to be rejected and the entire supply will have to be replaced with the quality exactly commensurate with the approved sample at the cost of the bidder. The decision of the Inspection Committee in this regard shall be final.
3. The time is the essence of the bid. The supply of the item as per the required specifications/samples shall be required to be made **within 75 days** in the Registry (F.O.R. Destination) on receipt of the Purchase Order.
4. The payment will be made only after the full supply is received and accepted as per approved samples/specifications. No part payment or advance payment shall be made.
5. The successful bidder will have to abide by the terms and conditions as may be fixed from time to time by the Registry.
6. Rates quoted shall include costs of commuting, delivery and no separate travelling charges shall be admissible.
7. Quality no./Brand should be printed on selvage of each cut piece of raymond fabric.

C. PENALTIES
