CIRCULAR

Sub.: Automated Case Information Retrieval and Entry in ICMIS

1. To further streamline case information management, administrative efficiency and ensure better administration of justice by minimizing errors likely to occur in manual data entry, the Court's case management software [ICMIS] is now upgraded to automatically fetch the relevant case-related data from the database of High Courts, District Courts [including FIR and Police Station related information from the official data maintained by Government]. Section I-B shall henceforth enter the case information in ICMIS, as may be automatically fetched by virtue of such mechanism.
2. Learned Advocates-on-Record and Parties-in-Person are encouraged to henceforth mention in the Proforma for First Listing, the CNR (Case Number Record)¹ of the matter as was assigned to the matter by the concerned Court whose order/judgment is under challenge. This would facilitate retrieval of case details from the concerned Court in automated manner, thereby ensuring accuracy of data and efficient case management.
3. CNR number of a particular case can be retrieved using the eCourts official website, through the *Case Status* option, available for District Courts² and High Courts³ by searching the case using the relevant party name, case number, filing number, or other available parameters.
