In continuation of Circulars dated 31.01.2026 and 02.02.2026(Copy enclosed) regarding implementation of Parking Authorization Record Keeper (PARK) for applying RFID-Chip based stickers (RFID Tags) for staffs of the Registry, Coordinate Agencies and other Stakeholders such as CPWD, Supreme Court Security, NALSA, SCLSC etc. for entry of vehicles from Gate no. 1, Administrative Buildings Complex, it is hereby informed that the competent authority has been pleased to extend the time period for next two months for applying the RFID-Chips based stickers/RFID Tags through portal.

Sub.: Implementation of Integrated Online Payment System (IOPS) and Parking Authorization Record Keeper (PARK).

The following initiatives are being implemented to enhance operational efficiency and transparency: -

- A. Integrated Online Payment System (IOPS) – accessible through the URL <https://www.sci.gov.in/iops/>

IOPS provides a unified online payment platform for making payments towards various administrative services, including Registration for AOR examination, payment of AOR examination fees, crèche charges, Guest House charges, Pensioner/Miscellaneous ID fees etc. The platform is integrated with Bharat Kosh as well as PFMS (Public Financial Management System) and it aims to simplify the process of the above-mentioned payments to ensure user convenience and transparency.

Stakeholders are requested to refer to the enclosed user manual (Annexure-A) for guidance.

- B. Parking Authorization Record Keeper (PARK) – accessible through the URL <https://park.sci.gov.in/>

To further streamline the management of vehicle movement within the precincts of the Supreme Court of India, PARK offers an automated and transparent platform for online submission and processing of requests for issuance of parking stickers and RFID tags. Currently, it shall be used for applying for RFID tags.

PARK provides a secure OTP-based login for applicant authentication and dashboard access, automated verification including RC expiry

checks, automatic RFID deactivation upon RC expiry, real-time electronic processing of applications, online tracking of application status at every stage, a dedicated Notice module to view and download notices issued for violations and a structured approval workflow that strengthens accuracy, accountability, and record-management.

Applicants are requested to refer to the user manual at Annexure-B for guidance in using PARK.

Currently, PARK shall be available on trial basis for staffs of the Registry, and Admn. Security branch shall issue a detailed circular regarding the matter.

Ref:- Revised Circular dated 31.01.2026, Implementation of Integrated Online Payment System (IOPS) and Parking Authorized Record Keeper (PARK)

It is hereby informed that consequent upon the successful completion of the trial of RFID-Chip based stickers for regulating entry of vehicles of Registry Staff, Coordinate Agencies and other stakeholders such as CPWD, Supreme Court Security, NALSA, SCLSC etc. entering from Gate No.1, Administrative Buildings Complex, the Competent Authority has been pleased to order for implementation of **Parking Authorization Record Keeper (PARK)** for applying **RFID-Chip based stickers (RFID Tags)** for all concerned.

Therefore, entry of vehicles from Gate No.1, Administrative Buildings Complex shall soon be only through RFID-Chip based stickers (RFID Tags). It is, therefore, impressed upon all concerned, having valid parking stickers, to apply for RFID-Chip based stickers (RFID Tags) from Parking Authorization Record Keeper (PARK) accessible through the URL <https://park.sci.gov.in/>.

However, in order to avoid hardship to the staff members of this Registry and other stakeholders, the Competent Authority has also been pleased to direct that during the transitional phase (within 2 months) of migrating to RFID-Chip based sticker (RFID Tags), vehicles with either valid parking sticker or RFID Chip based sticker (RFID Tags), will be allowed entry from Gate No.1, Administrative Buildings Complex, Supreme Court of India.
