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The Registrar's Courts shall continue to function in hybrid-mode.

The cases where the stipulated period given by the Registrar's Court or the Hon'ble Judge-in-Chambers or the Hon'ble Court for taking any steps in the matter has not expired, the same may not be taken up before the Registrar's Court during the partial Court working days. The cases, which are incomplete/'Not Ready' even after the expiry of the stipulated period or where no such order exists, may be taken up before the Registrar's Court. The regular matters which have become ready during the vacation may also be taken up for orders as regards pre-final hearing.

For this purpose, Computer Cell shall provide a list of such incomplete/'Not Ready' misc./regular matters immediately and on getting the list, the Sections concerned will get the matters taken up before above officers in the Registrar's Court.

All the Sections shall also verify old files upto the year 2025 on each working day to identify whether any of them has become infructuous or covered by decision of this Hon'ble Court. The list of such infructuous/covered cases be furnished to the concerned Registrar who in turn will forward the list to Registrar (J) (Judicial Listing-I) after due verification for listing.
