Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.

7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.

9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and
- All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.1 The eligibility criteria for the Prospective Tenderer which need to be complied with the technical bid and will form part of Technical Evaluation is as follows:

- a) The bidder should have Manufacturer's Authorization Form (**MAF**) for supply of Nikon DSLR Cameras on the letter head of OEM.
- b) The tenderer must comply with the technical specifications of Nikon Z8 camera with zoom lens as per the OEM standard or as amended from time to time.
- c) Bidder must have valid GST Registration Certificate. A copy of the same should be enclosed with the Technical-Bid.
- d) Bidder must possess valid PAN Card. A copy of the same should be enclosed with the Technical-Bid.
- e) The Bidder must have an office in Delhi/NCR, with a view to support prompt and expeditious services.

Note: The Tenderer will be evaluated based on meeting the tender criteria and shall normally be awarded to the lowest evaluated bidder whose bid has been found to be responsive and who is eligible and qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.

4. BID SUBMISSION

4.1 Technical Bid (PART –I)

Technical bid shall contain the following documents to be uploaded. All the documents must be sequentially numbered and uploaded in the below mentioned chronological order.

(This complete document including Terms & Conditions and Other Instructions etc.)
- ii. Signed and stamped copy of duly filled **Technical Bid Proforma** as per format **at Annexure 'A'**
- iii. Signed and stamped copy of **Undertaking/ Declaration** as per format **at Annexure 'B'** on the letter head of the bidding firm.
- iv. Signed and stamped copy of (**MAF**) as per format **at Annexure 'C'** of this document on

- v. Signed and stamped copy of **(Price fall certificate)** as per format at **Annexure 'D'**
- vi. Signed/ Stamped proof of their domicile in Delhi/NCR along with address of the office
- vii. Signed/ Stamped copy of PAN Number
- viii. Signed/ Stamped copy of GST Registration

Note: Every page must be signed and stamped by the authorized official of the bidder/tenderer firm, failing which, it is liable to be rejected.

4.2 Financial Bid (PART –II)

4.2.1 The Price Bid shall contain only schedule of rates duly filled. No stipulation, deviation, terms & conditions, presumptions etc. is permissible in price part of the bid. The Registry shall not take any cognizance of any such conditions and may at its discretion reject such price bid.

4.2.2 In case of any discrepancy/difference in the amounts indicated in figures and words, the amount in words will prevail and will be considered.

4.2.3 Bidders shall submit the tender online on GeM Portal only on or before the due date and time of bid submission. Tender submitted by any other form (fax/email/courier/post/hard copy) or after the due date and time of bid submission will be summarily rejected.

5. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TENDER

5.1 The bidder/ tenderer must read all the instructions, terms & conditions and specifications carefully and ensure compliance there with. Failing to furnish all the information as required by the tender document in any respect will be at the bidder's/ tenderer's risk and may result in rejection of the bid/ tender.

5.2 The bidder/ tenderer should have a registered office/ Branch office in Delhi/NCR and should upload proof of their domicile in Delhi/NCR along with address of the office in view of prompt and expeditious after sale service/warranty etc.

5.3 The rates quoted online should be inclusive of all Govt. levies etc. and no additional charges transport/ carry charges or any other charges will be paid by the Supreme Court Registry.

5.4 Certified translated copy of supporting documents should be uploaded in English, in case of documents available in Regional/ vernacular language.

5.5 Those Technical bids which are found to be in order i.e. satisfying all the stipulated conditions for Nikon Z8 camera with zoom lens shall be short-listed and financial bids of only such short-listed bidders will be opened. The bidder not fulfilling eligibility conditions of the tender will not be considered under any circumstances.

5.6 The Registry will deal with the tenderer directly and no middlemen/agents/commission agents etc., should be asked by the tenderer to represent their cause and they will not be entertained by the Registry.

5.7 In case of more than one L1 bid emerging, the bidder will be decided as per the GeM guidelines.

5.8 Registry is not bound to accept the lowest bid/ tender and reserves the right to reject or accept any or all the bids/ tenders, partly or completely, at any time without assigning any reason thereof.

5.9 The Registry reserves the right to make any change, at any time, in the terms and conditions of the Notice Inviting Tender and accept or reject any or all tenders wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof.

5.10 The decision of the Registry will be final conclusive and binding on the bidder and the Registry takes no responsibility for any delay whatsoever for submission of tender after the last date and time given in the schedule.

5.11 The Registry has the absolute right to accept or reject any or all offers, adjourn, postpone or cancel the tender. In case a single bid is received for the tender, it will be deemed to be a case of lack of competition. In this regard, decision of Supreme Court of India shall be final.

5.12 In case the successful bidder fails to supply the goods within 15 days from the date of issue of purchase order, the Registry reserves the right to terminate the agreement or undertake suitable action at its discretion.

5.13 The rates should be valid for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of tenders. The bidder/ tenderer shall not be entitled during the said period of 90 days to revoke or cancel its bid/ tender or to vary the tender or any terms thereof.

5.14 The bidders/ tenderers shall give an undertaking (as per Annexure -'B') that the Firm/Partners/Director/Proprietor has not been blacklisted and their business dealings with Central/State Government/Public Sector Units/Autonomous Bodies have not been banned/terminated on account of poor performance.

5.15 The Registry reserves the right to seek clarification or verification of any information supplied by the bidder.

5.16 Hypothetical or conditional tenders will not be entertained. Tender once submitted shall not be allowed to be withdrawn or altered. In the event of tender being withdrawn / altered, the tenderer may be debarred to participate in the tender process of the Supreme Court of India in future or liable for any other action as deemed fit.

5.17 Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one Bidder or Bidders having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

5.18 The tenderers are required to quote the competitive rates online for SUPPLY OF 1 UNIT OF NIKON Z8 DSLR camera with zoom lens with prescribed specifications on GeM portal only as per the detailed specifications annexed herewith (**Annexure E**).

5.19 The bidder shall be responsible for safeguarding its own material during delivery, at its own cost. Any damage/spoiling of lift/floor/caused during such act will have to be made good by the agency at his/its own expenditure.

5.20 The tenderer should provide the name and telephone/mobile number of person, who can be contacted at any time, even beyond office hours and on holidays for after-sale-service during the warranty period.

5.21 In case the supplies are not found in conformity with the approved specifications and any complaint is received about its quality and performance during the course of their use/utilization, the entire supply will have to be replaced with the good one/quality exactly commensurate with the approved specifications at the cost of the tenderer. The decision of the Registry in this regard shall be final.

5.22 During the warranty period, the tenderer shall provide onsite services related to maintenance of Nikon Z8 camera with zoom lens. Any problem related to maintenance, and other functional issues shall be attended & rectified by the tenderer.

5.23 The tenderer shall maintain the equipment as per OEM's guidelines, industry standards and shall use only standard / compatible / equivalent components for replacement during the warranty period. The original specification/ characteristics / features of the equipment shall not be changed without prior intimation to the Supreme Court of India.

5.24 The warranty of the product shall be deemed to commence from the date of successful installation of each unit in which regard the successful tenderer would have to obtain a Satisfactory Working Report from National Judicial Museum & Archive after supply of the said product.

5.25 The product supplied will be inspected by an Inspection Committee consisting of Senior Officers of the Registry and in case the supply is not found in conformity with the make/model/specifications and any complaints received about its quality and performance during the course of their use/utilization, the supplied product will have to be replaced with the good quality exactly commensurate with approved make/model/specifications at the cost of the tenderer. The decision of the Committee in this regard shall be final and binding.

5.26 The successful tenderer would take up any repairs, if required, that would be carried out on-site itself. If for some reason, it is not possible to carry out the necessary repair at the place where the item is installed/supplied, prior permission in writing shall be taken before taking the item to the workshop of the tenderer. However, in case the item is not likely to be repaired within 6 hours the firm will provide a standby for the same till the faulty item is repaired.

6. PAYMENT TERMS

6.1 The payment will be made after supply is received and accepted as per approved specifications satisfactorily. No part payment or advance payment will be made on receipt of pre-receipted bill/invoice from the successful bidder.

6.2 Penalty, if any, shall be deducted from any of the outstanding payment due to the tenderer.

6.3 Statutory deductions shall be made as per applicable rules.

7. PRICE FALL CLAUSE CERTIFICATE

7.1 Tenderers are required to furnish the PFC (Price Fall Clause) Certificate as per the format given in **Annexure 'D'**.

8. PENALTIES / LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

8.1 Delivery of the material shall be required to be made within 15 days on receipt of the Purchase Order. Non availability of material shall not be accepted as a ground for delay in supply and shall equally be penalized.

8.2 In the event that any employee of the supplier is found liable for theft, loss, or damage to office property, the bidder shall be held accountable for any resulting compensation claims.

8.3 Irrespective of the fact whether the Registry gets the job done from the outside, a penalty of 1% of total cost of delayed job per hour subject to 10% of maximum will be deducted from the bill in respect of the jobs which are not done within the stipulated period. The same will not be charged if the standby arrangement is made during the prolonged repair period.

8.4 In case of breach of any conditions or unsatisfactory service during the currency of contract, the Registry shall have a right to terminate the purchase order and to entrust the work to another contractor. 10. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES

10.1 Since both the parties are independent entities, under no circumstance will the employees of the successful bidder/ tenderer be deemed the employees of the Supreme Court of India Registry. The Purchase order shall, therefore, not grant any authority to the successful bidder/ tenderer to act for Supreme Court of India Registry in any capacity on its behalf.

11. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

11.1 Supreme Court of India Registry shall be solely entitled to any Intellectual Property Right (IPR) emanating or in any way related to this tender bid/ process. If any infringement to such IPR is observed during the currency of the Purchase order or any time thereafter, suitable legal action may be initiated by the Supreme Court of India Registry.

12.1 The successful bidder/ tenderer shall ensure that the specific terms and conditions of the contract will also be treated as confidential information and that no disclosures will be made in any form without the prior written consent of the Supreme Court of India Registry, except (i) As required by applicable disclosure law; (ii) To accountants, Banks, Financing Sources, lawyers, etc., subject to a duty not to disclose to others or (iii) in connection with the enforcement of this Purchase Order.

13. JURISDICTION

13.1 Since the contract shall be governed by and interpreted under, the laws of the Republic of India and Courts at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try, entertain and decide the matters arising out of and in relation to the Purchase Order. All disputes and differences are, however, subject to the jurisdiction of the courts situated in Delhi.

14. ARBITRATION

14.1 In the event of any dispute or difference or disagreement between the parties in respect of any matter relating to or arising out of the Agreement/ Purchase Order, the parties shall endeavor to resolve amicably any such disagreement or dispute by direct informal negotiation.

14.2 If the parties fail to resolve such a dispute or difference or disagreement by mutual consultation within twenty eight (28) days from the commencement of such consultation, either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution to the Competent Authority.

15. FORCE MAJEURE

15.1 In case the successful bidder/ tenderer is unable to fulfill the obligation under the contract owing to Force Majeure situation like war, fire, earthquake, floods, embargoes, act of terrorism etc., which are beyond the control of the parties, the successful bidder/ tenderer shall promptly notify Supreme Court Registry in writing of such condition and cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by Supreme Court of India Registry in writing, the successful bidder/ tenderer shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as it is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.
