FORWARD AUCTION-CUM BID NOTICE THROUGH GeM PORTAL FOR AUCTION OF
NINE VEHICLES UNDER ELV CATEGORY, ON BEHALF OF THE REGISTRY OF
SUPREME COURT OF INDIA

Supreme Court of India, an apex Judicial Body under Constitution of India intends to invite online bids for the Auction-cum-sale of vehicles as mentioned hereunder at Table-'A', on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" through Forward Auction through GeM Portal (Auction ID : 39123) from Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSF) under End-of Life Vehicle (ELV) category.

2. The bidders must quote the consolidated price for the whole lot. It is to be noted that the CONSOLIDATED HIGHEST RATE as quoted by the bidders shall only be considered. The contract will, therefore, be awarded to the bidder with the highest **Consolidated Total Price**.

3.2 Those interested are advised to regularly visit GeM Portal and official website of Supreme Court of India i.e. <https://www.sci.gov.in/notice-category/tenders> to keep themselves updated with any change/modification in the Forward Auction Notice which will be intimated through these websites only by corrigendum / addendum / amendment. No individual correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

4. INFORMATION RELATED TO THE AUCTION

4.1 The bids will be accepted on GeM (Forward Auction) Portal only and will be opened as per SOP of GeM.

4.2 **The bidders/firms who are having the valid Registered Vehicle Scraping Facility (RVSF) Certificate (as per provision of MoRTH) are only eligible to participate for the ELV scrap.**

4.3 Bidding will be done online for whole lot of vehicles and shall be sold to the bidder who will quote the highest rate for the whole lot.

4.4 Participation and bidding in the tender shall be treated as conclusive evidence of the fact that the bidder has inspected the items and documents pertaining to it and is satisfied in all respects regarding quantity, quality, and condition of the vehicles.

4.5 Any taxes, charges & duties, etc., if applicable at the time of taking delivery will have to be borne by the successful bidder and the Supreme Court Registry will not be liable to make any payment in this regard to anyone.

4.6 **The interested parties may contact Branch Officer, Transport Branch (Tel. No. : 011-23115910) for inspecting the vehicles on any working day between 10:30 AM to 04:30 PM, (except Sunday and Public Holidays) by prior appointment** during the period from 02.09.2026 to 15.09.2026 to satisfy themselves about the quantity, quality & condition of the vehicles being offered. No request for inspection after submission of the bids will be accepted. Bidders are advised to quote rates only after inspection of the vehicles at the site on 'AS-IS-WHERE IS' basis.

4.7 Bidders are advised to contact GeM Helpdesk directly in the following circumstances:

- (i) Functionality/ User Interface of GeM Portal/ GeM Forward Auction Portal.**
- (ii) Technical Issues at any stage of the Forward Auction.**
- (iii) Any other issues/ grievance/ query related to the GeM Portal.**

5. PRE-QUALIFICATION (PQ) ASSESSMENT

5.1 The **bidders shall upload following documents for PQ assessment** before due date and time :

- (i) **Annexure- 'A'** Proforma duly filled and signed.
- (ii) **Annexure- 'B'** Tender Acceptance Letter duly signed.
- (iii) Self attested copy of valid Registered Vehicle Scraping Facility (RVSF) **Certificate**
- (iv) **GST Registration and PAN card.**

6. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

6.1 The qualified bidders are required to deposit an amount of **Rs. 8,000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand only)** as **Earnest Money**, through online mode on GeM Portal, as per the schedule mentioned in "Critical Date Sheet" and guidelines of GeM.

6.2 Online bids received without applicable EMD will be summarily rejected.

6.3 The Earnest Money Deposit of unsuccessful bidders shall be auto-refunded to their source account after generating the sale intimation letter to the successful bidder, through GeM only.

7. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE FORWARD AUCTION**

7.1 The bidders are expected to read all the instructions, proformas, terms & conditions and specifications in the bid documents carefully. Failing to furnish all information required by the bid document in every respect will be at the bidders' risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

7.2 The bidders are required to quote their single rate for whole Lot of vehicles (Table-A of this Notice). The bid will be confirmed in favour of the bidder quoting the **highest rate** in respect of whole lot.

7.3 The Registry, in its discretion, reserves the right to reject or accept any or all the bids, at any time without assigning any reason thereof.

7.4 Each bidder has to certify that all the terms and conditions are acceptable to him/ her. The Earnest Money Deposit shall stand forfeited in case of breach of any of the conditions mentioned herein.

7.5 All the pages of the documents uploaded therein must be duly signed and stamped failing which the offer shall be liable for rejection.

7.6 The bidders shall give all the information/details duly signed and stamped in the Proforma at Annexure 'A'.

7.7 The bidders/ tenderers shall give Forward Auction Notice Acceptance Letter duly filled, signed and stamped as per Annexure -'B'.

7.8 Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

7.9 The Registry, in its discretion, reserves the right to reject or accept any or all tenders, partly or completely, at any time without assigning any reason thereof.

7.10 The Registry reserves the right to make any change, at any time, in the terms and conditions of the Forward Auction Notice and accept or reject any or all tenders wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof.

7.11 **It is not binding on the part of the Registry to accept the highest quoted rate as submitted by any bidder for any reason whatsoever.**

8. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUCCESSFUL BIDDER**

8.1 The Final Payment/ balance sale value (arrived at after adjusting EMD from the actual sale

value but including all applicable taxes) shall have to be paid by the successful Bidder within 10 (ten) days for the whole lot of vehicles from the date of bid acceptance in the form of Bank Draft/ Demand Draft (DD) drawn in favour of “The Registrar, ‘Supreme Court of India’ payable at New Delhi”.

8.2 The final payment/balance sale value, including all taxes, if not paid within the prescribed time limits, shall be paid within such time limit as may be extended by the Registry, together with any Ground Rent / Charges @ Rs 10/- per vehicle per day or part of a day, or 0.5 % of the value of the whole lot of vehicles remaining undelivered per day or part of a day whichever is higher. Such ground rent or any other charges that the Registry may have incurred shall be recovered from the successful bidder before the lot of vehicles is delivered.

8.3 Any statutory variations in the rate of Govt. Levies/taxes/duties as on the date of delivery of vehicles will be borne by the successful bidder. The actual GST, as applicable, shall be borne by the successful bidder.

8.4 The successful/highest bidder (RVSF) shall take possession of the auctioned lot of vehicles and pick up the vehicles for scrapping at its own cost and risk, from Transport Branch, Supreme Court of India and in any case within 10 days from the date of Bid Acceptance. The Supreme Court Registry shall not in any manner, be concerned with or responsible for the vehicles, and will have no liability whatsoever after the delivery of said vehicles to the successful bidder.

8.5 No picking, choosing, sorting, welding, cutting, or breaking of goods or materials sold will be permitted under any circumstances. Unused/waste oil, separation of oil and water, and so on, shall not be allowed at the site. The bidder shall not be entitled to re-sell an item, lot, or part of a lot while the goods are still lying within the premises of the Registry and any such sale or assignment will not be recognised. All document for releasing material will be made out in the name of the Buyer only.

8.7 The Lot of Vehicles sold but not removed/taken possession thereof within the specified date will become the property of the Registry and it will have the right to dispose of such vehicles in any manner as it deems fit without any notice.

8.8 The Registry will not be, in any way, responsible for failure to deliver the material due to causes beyond its control such as a strike, lockout, cessation of work by labourers, shortened hours, act of God or other causes or other contingencies whatsoever. The successful bidder shall not be entitled to cancel the contract and the period of delivery shall automatically be extended proportionately at the discretion of the Registry.

8.9 **Transaction Charges** in case of Forward Auction shall be paid by the successful bidder to GeM (as per their terms and conditions) at the time of acceptance of concerned order. For the exact details of transaction charges and GST rates etc., the successful bidder may refer to the relevant revenue policy on the GeM website or portal.

8.10 The successful bidder shall ensure that scrapping of the vehicle is done as per environmental guidelines and rules under CPCB/SPCB, and shall furnish a Certificate of Vehicle Scrapping in terms of Rule 11 (1) of MoRTH Notification No. GSR. 653 (E) dated 23.09.2021

within 30 days after lifting of Vehicles.

8.11 The successful bidder shall complete all RTO formalities, including transfer/deregistration/scrapping, at their own cost, and De-registration of vehicle shall be carried out by the RVSF strictly as per prescribed guidelines by MoRTH.

9. PENALTIES

9.1 In the event the successful bidder fails to make the requisite payment within the time / extended time stipulated, the sale relating to vehicles will be cancelled at the discretion of the Registry, and the EMD deposited by the Bidder shall be forfeited in full, and the Registry shall be entitled to recover any incidental / consequential loss suffered by it as a result of such failure.

9.2 If in case of failing to deposit the Payment within the stipulated time, the Buyer can deposit the balance sale value with payment of interest charges for the delays involving a maximum of up to 30 (thirty) days for the vehicles with interest thereupon. The rate of interest charged on delayed payment will be 7% above the “Base rate of State Bank of India” as prevailing on the last date of payment originally indicated in the Bid.

9.3 If such vehicles are not removed on payment of ground rent within 30 (thirty) days from the expiry of the period as prescribed, the Registry may, at its discretion, terminate the contract and order the resale of such vehicles and forfeit all the money paid by the successful bidder in respect thereof without making any reference to the bidder. The vehicles shall be deemed to have been abandoned by the successful bidder to all intents and purposes.

9.4 Compliance with Laws : The bidder shall ensure compliance with the provisions contained in E-waste management and Handling Rules, 2017, Batteries (Management and Handling) rule 2011 and all other relevant Rules/Guidelines issued in this regard.

9.5 Arbitration : The courts at Delhi will have the jurisdiction to try any matter, dispute or reference between the parties arising out of the contract. It is specifically agreed that no court outside and other the court shall have jurisdiction in the matter by Government for its disposal/recycling in an environment friendly manner.

9.6 The successful bidder will have to abide by the terms and conditions as may be fixed from time to time by the Registry of Supreme Court of India, New Delhi.
