



CITY CIVIL AND SESSIONS COURT, MUMBAI

In 1728, under a Royal Charter, the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Jail (Gao) delivery, came to be established in Bombay. The Court was composed of the Governor and some members of his Council, who as justices of the Peace, had jurisdiction to try all offences except high treason.

In 1798, the Recorder's Court with powers to exercise Civil and Criminal Jurisdiction, was created. In 1824, the Recorder's Court was replaced by the Supreme Court with jurisdiction confined to the town and island of Bombay. At about the same time, Dindoshi
