3. Whether the appeal is in time and if not, by how many days it is beyond time and whether an application for condonation of delay is filed with it along with an affidavit in support of the same, as provided in rule 3-A of order XLI of C.P.C. ? : Yes. By calculating the copying days.
: No. it is beyond time of days and an application for condonation of delay is filed as provided.
4. Whether the memorandum is accompanied by the copies of the Judgment and decree or a copy of the Judgment, as provided in rule 6-a of order XX of C.P.C. ? : Yes/ Copy of Exh.5 of Trial Court attached.
5. Whether the appeal is properly stamped ? : Yes Rs. paid.
6. Whether the names of the parties stated in the memorandum corresponds with the names given in the copies annexed ? : Yes.
7. Whether the addresses given are registered address of the parties? : Yes.

Note: If the valuation stated in the memorandum of appeal differs from the valuation given in the plaint, the difference should be explained and accounted for in a foot note to the memorandum of appeal.
