RULES OF ELIGIBILITY SPECIFYING THE QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND DISQUALIFICATIONS AS ENLAID IN HON'BLE HIGH COURT ROC.2589/95/E1, DATED: 29.03.1997

I. QUALIFICATIONS:

A PERSON

- Who has held a post in the A.P. Judicial Ministerial Services not below the rank of Superintendent of District Court or Senior Civil Judge or Junior Civil Judge's Court and has a law degree; or
- ii) Who has held a post of Section Officer and above in the Andhra Pradesh High Court Services and has Law Degree; or
- iii) A non-practicing Advocate with a practice at the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years of age; or

- iv) Any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree or who has passed the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of Indian Penal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure) conducted by the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial powers during his/her tenure of service for not less than three years. And who has at least one year of complete 65 years of age at the date fixed by the Court in the year of recruitment shall alone be eligible.
- v) Provided that a suitable retired Judicial Officer shall be preferred.

II. DISQUALIFICATION:

A PERSON

- i) Who is a practicing Advocate; or
- ii) Who is a member of any State or Local Authority; or
- iii) Who is a member of the State Legislature or of the Parliament or
- iv) A person, who having held an Officer under the State or the Union Government or any Local Authority, has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct, or
- A person who has been convicted and sentenced by a Court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged of any offence constituting moral turpitude and proceedings are pending, or
- vi) A person unsound mind or who is deaf or mute or blind or suffering from Leprosy or any other contagious disease or
- vii) A person adjudicated as insolvent or an undischarged insolvent, or
- viii) A contractor or a businessman or one interested in a subsisting contract or any work being done for Central or State Government or a Local Authority within whose limits the Special Magistrate has to discharge his duties, shall not be eligible.

III. REVOCATION OF POWERS OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES:

- On appointment and while in service a Special Magistrate of II Class or Special Magistrate of any other category may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he fails to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate or the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, as the case may be.
- ii) Powers conferred by the Court on Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class or Special Magistrate of any other category shall automatically stand withdrawn on his attaining the age of 65 years.
