- b) Must have failed or passed 10th class examination for the post of Court Attendant.
- c) Any retired person who held any post i.e Assistant, Examiner, Typist, Copyist and above in the Judicial Department is eligible for appointment of Court Assistant. Any retired person who held the post of Attender, Process Server or in any post in the last grade service in the Judicial Department is eligible for appointment of Court Attendant.
