Subject:- Subject: Non-updation of Delay Reasons in CIS Software by Concerned Clerk


As per our previous communication through Order No. 37/PDJG, dated 22/07/2023, it was directed that all courts should update the delay reason of cases in CIS software. In that order, it was clearly directed to all Ahalmads (Civil/Criminal) of all the said courts to update the delay reason of cases in CIS software within a stipulated time frame. Unfortunately, despite the clear instructions, the Civil & Criminal Clerks of CJM Court and Criminal clerk of Munsiff Court have failed to comply with the directive.

In view of the seriousness of this matter and the importance of maintaining accurate and up-to-date records, I hereby request your immediate intervention. It is imperative that the concerned clerks update the delay reason of cases in CIS software without any further delay. They have been given an additional two days to complete the updates, with a deadline of **12 August 2023**.

If there is any further delay or non-compliance, the concerned clerks are directed to present themselves in the undersigned office with a proper explanation for their actions. This matter must be treated as a high priority, and urgent action should be taken against the concerned clerks.

You will take this matter seriously and ensure that necessary steps are taken to address the non-updation of delay reasons in the CIS software at the earliest. Timely action in this regard would not only reinforce the importance of adhering to directives but also ensure the efficient and accurate functioning of our judicial system.

It is imperative that all clerks comply with this directive in order to ensure the smooth functioning of court proceedings and maintain the integrity of the system. The timely update of the delay reason of cases in CIS software is crucial to streamlining and tracking case progression effectively.
