**Terms and conditions :**

1. **The last date for receipt of applications is 20/12/2024 till 5:00 pm.** Applications received beyond due date shall not be accepted and **this office shall not be responsible for any postal delay.**

**Eligibility criteria :**

2. Candidate must be an Indian Citizen as defined in Article 5 to 8 of the Constitution of India.
3. The candidate must have minimum qualification of VIII standard passed and those who have passed HSSLC (Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate) or above shall be ineligible to apply for the said post. Candidates possessing special skills may be given preference on need basis.
4. The candidate should not be less than 18 years and not more than 40 years of age as on the date of publication of the advertisement. Age relaxation will be as per Govt. norms for reserved categories.
5. No T.A./D.A. will be admissible for appearing in interview/viva voce etc. as the case may be.
6. Canvassing directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidature.
7. All information regarding list of eligible/rejected candidates, date of viva-voce/interview will be intimated in the **Official Website only**. No intimation will be sent individually to any candidate by post or otherwise. Candidates are advised to check the official website of <https://nalbari.dcourts.gov.in> regularly.

**8. Mode of Selection : -**

- (i) There will be interview/viva voce of 30 marks.
9. The selected candidates will have to submit an undertaking to the authority that they will abide by the New Pension Rules of Government.

The candidates may also submit applications in the drop box placed in the office room of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalbari. The candidate must mandatorily provide their contact number in their application.

Candidate will have to submit self-attested photocopies of all relevant testimonials of educational qualification, age, experience (if any), caste, valid employment exchange registration certificate and three self-attested recent passport size photographs with the application. The candidates will have to produce all the testimonials in original, in the event of being selected for interview/viva-voce, failing which his/her candidature will be rejected.
3. Candidates already in service are to apply through proper channel.
4. Incomplete application/defective application/application received beyond due date/application without required number of photographs shall be summarily rejected without further intimation to the applicant.
5. If a candidate is found to have suppressed his educational qualifications or given wrong information in his/her application, his/her candidature will be immediately rejected at any stage.
