In the light of Hon'ble Court's Notification No. 22/A dated 09.02.2024, pursuant to the direction given in the Judgment dated 04.01.2024 by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in W.P. (C) No. 643 of 2015 (All India Judges' Association Vs. Union of India & Others), the Committee for Service Conditions of the District Judiciary (CSCDJ) constituted by Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice of the Court formulated the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for proper implementation of the recommendations of the SNJPC in respect of pay, pension, allowances and all allied matters as approved by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India including all the payment of arrears of salary and pension of the Judicial Officers, pensioners and family pensioners etc. of the State.
