**Agenda No.1:Review of Agenda of Earlier meeting held on 27.01.2024-**

Agenda of earlier meeting held on 27.01.2024 was reviewed today in Coordination Meeting .The Undersigned expressed satisfactory.

**Agenda No.2: Delay in filing of final form in criminal cases:**

This Agenda was discussed between the S.P, Lohardaga with Undersigned in coordination Meeting. It has been observed that after institution of FIRs, concerned officer in charge of concerned police station depute the investigation officer to investigate the cases but due to lack of knowledge, they are unable to submit the final form in time. Sometimes it is also observed that newly recruited A.S.I or S.I are given charge to investigate the cases who are not aware to investigate the case. They should be properly trained by a team of trained police officers. Some cases like SC/ST cases, cases U/s 302 of I.P.C, U/s 376 of I.P.C and U/s 366 of I.P.C whose investigation are required to be done by the senior police officers for better result, I.O must ensure make Map of place of occurrence in each case for better result. It has also been discussed that some cases like rape i.e U/s 376 of I.P.C, FSL report is not submitted by State Government in time. It is also one of reasons for submitting final form lately. In Arms Act cases and offence U/s 153A, 295A of I.P.C , sanction report is also required to file the charge sheet but I.O are not able to obtain the sanction report in time and in lack of sanction report charge sheet/ Final form is not submitted in time and it becomes delay. Sanction report is also not submitted in time by the government specially in N.I.A Act as well as cases U/s UA(P) Act. These types of cases fail due to non-submission of sanction report. The S.P, Lohardaga has assured that an endeavor was taken and concerned was directed

to take step and bring progress in resolving the above problems.


**Agenda No.3: Execution of warrant of Arrest:**

This issues was also discussed in the coordination meeting. A lot of cases are pending due to non-execution of warrant of accused persons. Without execution of N.B.W, Court is unable to proceed the case and further proceeding of 82 Cr.P.C cannot be issued as per direction of Hon'ble Court. The S.P, Lohardaga has assured that all the pending warrants in all police stations under Lohardaga Judgeship will be executed promptly and a proper direction will be issued to all the concerned P.S. it has been told in meeting that permanent warrant, N.B.W, 82 Cr.P.C and 83 Cr.P.C of all Courts are being reviewed for proper execution in time.

**Agenda No.3: Production of witnesses:**

This Agenda was also discussed in coordination meeting. Production of witnesses are very necessary aspects for disposal of cases and it is good that witnesses are coming to the court. It has been observed that many criminal cases are pending in this Judgeship due to non-turning up of investigating officers and doctors. It has been resolved that I.Os who are witnesses either in Sessions Court or Magistrate Courts, a list of I.Os who has been transferred from Lohardaga Judgeship made be available to all courts so that summons may be sent to Concerned District at their Address by Courts. Although a team of police (C.N.O) is working to transmit the summons to concerned police officials/I.Os, however, more progress is also required. Office has been directed to send the list of cases pending for evidence of I.Os of all Courts. It has also been resolved that the doctors witness be sent through C.S-cum-C.M.O, Lohardaga. The S.P, Lohardaga assured to Undersigned to procure the I.Os/ police witnesses in time before the Court as well as those I.Os who have been transferred from this Lohardaga District through his Agency..

The meeting ended with mutual exchange of thanks by both participants for a responsive, cordial and conducive atmosphere of work to achieve the ends of Justice in the District.
