Sub: Matter pertains to revamping of the Unit Criteria for disposal of cases in Lok Adalats organized by the Madhya Pradesh State Legal Services Authority.

Ref: Registry Memo No. C/987/III-1-46/58, Jabalpur, dated 05/03/2020.

On the subject and reference cited above, as directed, this is to inform you that Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice has been pleased to allow the Judicial Officers participating in National Lok Adalat to claim 1 unit per case for the first 20 cases and 0.5 units per case for additional cases, up to total of 60 cases, allowing for a maximum of 40 units per Lok Adalat.

The proposed changes and calculation of units for disposal in Lok Adalat is as under:

Computation of units:

Units for the first 20 cases:

1 unit per case x 20 cases = 20 units

Units for the additional cases (21 to 60 cases):

Number of additional cases = 60 cases -20 cases = 40 cases

0.5 units per case x 40 cases = 20 units

Total possible units:

Units for the first 20 cases = 20 units

Units for the additional 40 cases = 20 units

Total = 20 units + 20 units = 40 units.

Note: The units may be awarded only for pending cases of a civil nature and criminal cases compoundable in nature (specifically excluding unregistered cases and summary cases). The unit awards may be based purely on the settlement between the parties. Units may also be awarded in miscellaneous judicial cases (both civil and criminal) resolved through settlement between the parties. However, no units may be awarded in miscellaneous judicial cases involving recovery proceedings (such as fines or forfeiture of bonds/surety) where only one party is involved.
