

09/13.09.2024: Learned counsel for the appellants submits that his bail bonds were not accepted by the Trial Court.

2. We had directed the bailors of the appellants to furnish the bail bonds along with sureties and document. If the Trial Court feels that the said is not in order or not in consonance with the order and direction passed by this Court, he can refuse to accept the same.

3. When bail bonds are filed with necessary documents, the Court before whom the bail bonds are filed needs to scrutinize the bail bonds and the documents attached with it. The Court has to see as to whether the bail bonds are in order and the bailors who are filing the bail bonds along with their documents, meets the conditions imposed by the Court granting bail or not. If the Court before whom the bail bonds along with document is presented, is not accepting the same due to want of necessary document or if the Court is not satisfied with the same, it is open for the Court to not accept the bail bonds. In that scenario, if the Court is refusing to accept the bail bonds for any reasons whatsoever, the said reasons should be mentioned in the ordersheet, indicating as to why he is not accepting the bail bonds. The concerned Court should not return the papers and documents without recording any reasons in the ordersheet for not accepting the same.

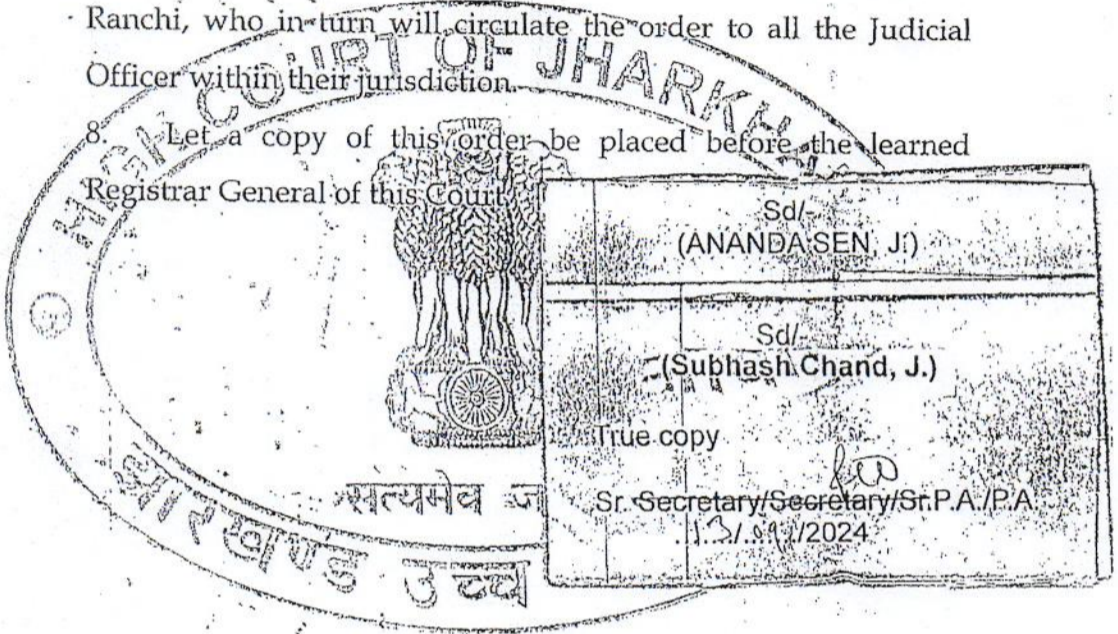
4. In this case, I direct the appellants to furnish the bail bonds within ten days.

5. The Trial Court will inform this Court as to whether the bail bonds have been accepted or not, if not, the reasons thereof should be mentioned.

6. List this case after two weeks.

7. Let a copy of this order be communicated to all the learned Principal District Judge and learned Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi, who in turn will circulate the order to all the Judicial Officer within their jurisdiction.

8. Let a copy of this order be placed before the learned Registrar General of this Court.
