Land Dispute Resolved Through DLSA... Pre-litigation Case No.-152/2022 dated : 06-12-2022 (Nadir Ali Mirza -vs- D.L&L.R.O, Jhargram)

Nadir Ali Mirza, a resident of Parihati village under the jurisdiction of Jamboni Police Station, visited the Office of the DLSA, Jhargram. He explained that his father, Sahid Ali Mirza, was one of the seven siblings who got a piece of land from their maternal grandmother. Later, Sahid Ali Mirza got the rest of the land from their brothers through a deed of gift.

But, when Sahid Ali Mirza, went to the B.L&L.R.O Office to attain his record of right he found that the name of one of his siblings i.e Safar Ali Mirza, is missing from the previous record of right.

Upon receiving this complaint, the DLSA in Jhargram took proactive steps by initiating a pre-litigation case (Case No. 152/2022, dated 06.12.2022). Notices were duly issued to both parties involved. The Secretary of DLSA, Jhargram, along with the legal advocate representing DLSA, Jhargram, engaged with both parties and provided counseling services. Following these counseling sessions, the OP requested some additional time to resolve the matter.

On October 05, 2023, the petitioner stated that the missing name was reinstated in the record of right and the problem of land dispute is resolved through amicable settlement. This resolution was achieved through the active intervention of DLSA, Jhargram.
