

Aadhar Card problem resolved through DLSA availing Examination Candidate to sit in Exam...

Jhuma Palai, a higher secondary student hailing from Sonakonia village in the Beliabera Police Station area of Jhargram district, faced a significant challenge. She had been without a portion of her left thumb since birth, which hindered her from obtaining an Aadhar Card. This became a significant obstacle as the examination authorities had made Aadhar Card submission mandatory for all higher secondary examinees.

Upon learning of Jhuma's predicament, PLV Rita Das Dutta, associated with the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) in Jhargram, promptly took action. On the 17th of October 2023, the Secretary of DLSA, Jhargram, successfully provided Jhuma Palai with a digital copy of her new Aadhar Card. Thus, a student is helped to attain her right through active intervention of DLSA, Jhargram.
