**Item No.1** : To discuss the matter relating to the strengthening of monitoring mechanism for expeditious investigation and trial of cases.

**Resolution:** The District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar, at the outset, welcomed all the members of the committee.


- (i) Initiating the discussion, the District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar apprised all the members about the receipt of some portions of the case diaries in digital form. Ld. Public Prosecutor, Sivasagar had placed on record the difficulty in reading the said digital documents due to lack of infrastructural facility. The District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar, accordingly proposed that along with the digital documents, the practice of submitting written documents may be continued till the necessary infrastructural facilities are made available. The District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar apprised the meeting that necessary steps would be taken in this regard at the earliest.
- (ii) The Public Prosecutor, Sivasagar informed that in NDPS cases Malkhana receipts are not brought on record for which chain of custody could not be established and accordingly requests for needful action by Police department. The Additional SP (Crime), Sivasagar submits that the I.O.s would be briefed accordingly.
- (iii) Additional District and Sessions Judge, FTC, Sivasagar placed before the meeting that disposal of old pending cases has become a difficulty due to non-attendance of I.O.s and places a list of such I.O.s before the Additional SP (Crime), Sivasagar to liason with them and secure their presence to ensure speedy disposal of old pending case.
- (iv) The District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar further continuing with the earlier resolution dated 31-08-2024 regarding the setting up of a De-addiction centre at Sivasagar brought to the notice that such a centre had been established at Chirang District recently and the model can be adopted at Sivasagar also as such a centre has become an utmost necessity due to the rise in number of NDPS cases and apprehension of drug addicts. It is noticed that without such a dedicated place, the

District Jail, Sivasagar is facing difficulty in keeping the drug addicts. Representative of District Commissioner, Sivasagar has apprised the meeting that steps would be taken in this regard at the earliest.

- (v) The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar, referred to the earlier resolution dated 31-08-2024 regarding the requirement of an Observation Home at Sivasagar and difficulties faced for its absence in the district. In this regard, the District Administration, Sivasagar is to take necessary steps for doing the needful.
