ORDER No. 187 /2024

Whereas it has come to the notice of undersigned that sometimes the first dates of the Suits/Cases/Petitions are being given in irregular manner at Centralized Computer Filing Counter of the judgship after its registration. It is also occasionally seen that the Suit or other cases remain pending for admission date after date awaiting office report from Saristedar as regards Stamp reporting, calculation of Court Fee and other defects. Further, it has also been brought to the notice of undersigned at times that Misc. Civil Applications filed in Centralized e-Filing Centre are kept posted for hearings on dates different from the date on which its original suit/case is posted for hearing which causes great inconvenience, harassment and unnecessary expenses to the poor litigants and sometimes injustice may occasion **to the parties to the lis.**

Any of such reports is clearly undesirable and require firm corrective measures in the light of Hon'ble the Court's direction for speeding up the proceedings/trials and to strengthen the Justice delivery system.

In order to obviate the unnecessary delay in office reporting by Saristedar, to put an end to any practice of irregular date giving at Centralized e-Filing Centre and to obviate any complication or harassment because of separate hearings of Misc. Civil Applications and its original suits, in the interest of Justice following directions are being issued.

(1) All the Suits/Cases/Petitions filed in the Centralized e-Filing Centre of the Judgship must be transmitted on the very same day forthwith to the Offices of the Court concerned for favour of its being put up before the Presiding Officer of the Court concerned for necessary order.

Provided that in Suits/Cases where there are numerous parties which takes time in registration, such suits/cases be transmltted to the Court concerned preferably on same date but if not possible then by next date.

Any undue delay in transmitting the cases/Suits/Petitions from Centralized e-Filing Centre to the Court concerned shall be viewed strictly.

(2) The Suits/Cases/Petitions received from Centralized e-Filing Centre to the Offices of the respective Courts have to be placed before the Presiding Officer forthwith for his/her consideration regarding further proceeding/necessary instruction and reasonable date for hearing.

In Suits/Cases/Petitions which require office report before its hearing, the Presiding Officer should order for calling for office report from Saristedar on points of Stamp, Court Fee, Defects etc. and for that a reasonable date be fixed in the record which should not be more than seven (07) days in first instance. If any report is not required the Courts are at liberty to hear the case as per law.


(3) Misc. Civil Applications filed in Centralized e-Filing Centre shall be transmitted on the same day forthwith to be placed before the Presiding Officer of the Court concerned. If any office report/note is required, the same shall forthwith be transmitted to the Saristedar for the purpose.

With a view to avoid any likely complication as well as to obviate any unnecessary inconvenience, harassment or extra expenses occasioned to the parties, it is advisable that every Misc Civil Application should be posted on same date with its original record except Injunction Petitions Under Order 39 R 1 and 2 of CPC. In no case, any Misc Civil Application except Injunction Petitions should be allowed to run on different date from its pending original suit or case from which said Misc Application has arisen. It goes without saying that Courts are at liberty to hear Injunction Petitions as per law.

(4) Misc. Criminal Application/Bail Petition/Anticipatory Bail Petitions filed in Centralized e-Filing Centre shall be transmitted to the concerned Court on the very same date forthwith for hearing.

To secure proper implementation of above direction, for convenience of Centralized e-Filing, Advocates, Litigants a tabular chart mentioning therein the direction for posting the date in all types of suits/cases/Petitions registered at Centralized e-Filing Centre is being annexed with this order.

Inform all concerned.


