Applications (in Triplicate) are invited up to **5-00 P.M. on 18.06.2024** in the prescribed format enclosed herewith for appointment to the posts of 1) **Special Judicial Magistrate II Class, Nizamabad, 2) Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class (for Railways), Nizamabad and 3) Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Armoor** from the eligible candidates for consideration. Applications received after due date will not be considered.

The term of the 1) *Special Judicial Magistrate II Class, Nizamabad, 2) Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class (for Railways), Nizamabad and 3) Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Armoor* will be completed from the date of assumption of charge. The term may be changed as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court. The Selected Candidates will be paid remuneration of **Rs.45,000/- + 5000/-** conveyance allowance per month.

RULES OF ELIGIBILITY SPECIFYING THE QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND DISQUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AS ENLAD IN HON'BLE HIGH COURT'S ROC.No.2589/95/E1, DATED: 29.03.1997.

I. QUALIFICATIONS:

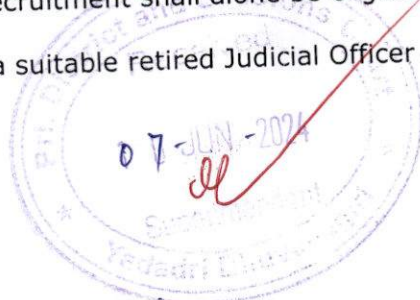
A PERSON

1. Who has held any post in Andhra Pradesh Higher Judicial Service or State Judicial Service and retired or resign, OR
2. Who has held a post in the Telangana State Judicial Ministerial Service not below the rank of Superintendent of District Court or Senior Civil Judge or Junior Civil Judge's Court and has a law degree: OR
3. Who has held a post of Section Officer and above in the Telangana State High Court Service and has a Law Degree, OR
4. A non-practicing Advocate with a practice at the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years of age **should file a Certificate of voluntary suspension of practice issued by the Bar Council of state of Andhra Pradesh OR Telangana**
5. Any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree OR who has passed the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of the Indian Penal Code and the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of the Indian Penal Code Criminal Procedure) conducted by the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission/Telangana State Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial posers during his tenure or service for not less than three years.

And who has at least one year to complete 65 years of age at the date fixed by the Court in the year of recruitment shall alone be eligible.

Provided that a suitable retired Judicial Officer shall be preferred.

II. DISQUALIFICATIONS:

A PERSON

1. Who is a practicing Advocate, OR
2. Who is a Member of any State or Local Authority, OR
3. Who is a Member of the State Legislature or of the Parliament, OR
4. A person who having held an Office under the State or the Union Government or any Local Authority has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct, OR
5. A person who has been convicted and sentenced by a Court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged with any offence constituting moral turpitude and proceedings are pending, OR
6. A person of unsound mind or who is deaf or mute or blind or suffering from Leprosy or any other contagious disease; OR
7. A person adjudicated as an insolvent or an un-discharged insolvent, OR
8. A contractor or a businessman or one interested in a subsisting contract or any work being done for Central or State Government or a Local Authority within whose limits the Special Magistrate has to discharge his duties shall not be eligible.

III. REVOCATION OF POWERS OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES:

1. On appointment and while in service a Special Magistrate of Second Class or Special Magistrate of any other category may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he fails to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate or the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, as the case may be.
2. Powers conferred by the Court on Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class or Special Magistrate of any other category shall automatically stand withdrawn on his attaining the age of 65 years.

IV. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. As per the Hon'ble High Court Circular ROC.No.802/SO/97, dated 29/01/1998 the Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class Courts are functioning for (05) days in a week i.e. from Monday to Friday on working days between 7.30 AM to 10.30 AM.
2. The appointing authority reserves the right to cancel the Notification without assigning any reason thereof.
3. No T.A. will be paid for candidate for journey performed in connection with recruitment.
4. All the necessary copies of documents such as, qualification certificates, retirement proceedings etc., and applications do not contain necessary enclosures as detailed above will be rejected.
