Sub: High Court for the State of Telangana – Family Courts Act – Information received from the District Judiciary regarding Institution, Disposal and Pendency of cases in Family Court in the State of Telangana – Committee Meeting held on 24-06-2024 – Certain instructions issued - Reg.

Adverting to the subject cited, I am inform that the Committee of Hon'ble Judges dealing with Sensitization of Family Courts in its meeting held on 24-06-2024, has issued the following directions to the District Judiciary:

- "Maintenance, Domestic Violence, Guardianship, Restitution of Conjugal Rights Cases and similar cases that are compoundable may be referred to the Lok Adalats.
- The Principal District Judges of the Districts may be requested to conduct Lok Adalats more frequently apart from the Lok Adalats designated by NALSA.
- Mediators may be given suitable time frame of 2 weeks for mediation depending on the complexity of the case.
- Mediators should be requested to ensure appearance of both the parties in the proceedings."

Therefore, as directed, the Unit Heads instructed to take necessary steps in the matter and the action taken be intimated to the undersigned on or before 15th July, 2024, for placing the same before the Committee of Hon'ble Judges, for their Lordships' kind perusal and consideration.
