RULES OF ELIGIBILITY SPECIFYING THE QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND DISQUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AS ENVISAGED IN THE HON'BLE HIGH COURT'S ROC.NO. 2589/95/E1, DATED 29.03.1997

1.QUALIFICATIONS :-

A person

i) who has held any post in Telangana State Higher Judicial Service or State Judicial Service and retired or resigned;

OR

ii) who has held a post in Telangana Ministerial Service not below the rank of Superintendent District Courts or Senior Civil Judge or Junior Civil Judge's Court and has a Law Degree.

OR

iii) who has held a post of Section Officer and above in the Telangana High Court Service and has a Law Degree.

iv) A Non-practicing Advocate with a practice at the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years of age should file a certificate of voluntary suspension of practice issued by the Bar Council for the State of Telangana.

OR

v) Any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree or who has passed the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of the Indian Penal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure) conducted by the Telangana or Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial powers during his tenure of service for not less than three years. Who has atleast one year to complete 65 years of age at the date fixed in the year of recruitment shall alone be eligible.

OR

vi) provided that a suitable retired Judicial Officer shall be preferred.

II. DISQUALIFICATIONS

A person

- 1) Who is practicing Advocate **OR**
- 2) Who is Member of any State or Local Authority; **OR**
- 3) Who is a Member of the State Legislature or of the Parliament **OR**
- 4) who is having held an Officer under the State or the Union Government or any Local Authority, has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct, **OR**
- 5) who has been convicted and sentenced by a Court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged of any offence constituting moral turpitude proceedings are pending **OR**
- 6) A person unsound mind or who is deaf or mute or blind or suffering from Leprosy or any other contagious disease **OR**
- 7) A person adjudicated as insolvent or an undersigned insolvent, **OR**
- 8) A contract or a businessman or one interested in a subsisting contract or any work being done for Central or State Government or a Local Authority within whose limits the Special Magistrate has to discharge his/her duties, shall not be eligible.
- 9) If the individual refuses or does not join within fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of the appointment orders, he/she shall forfeit his/her claim to the post of Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class;
- 10) The services of the Officers selected shall be liable to be terminated without any notice.

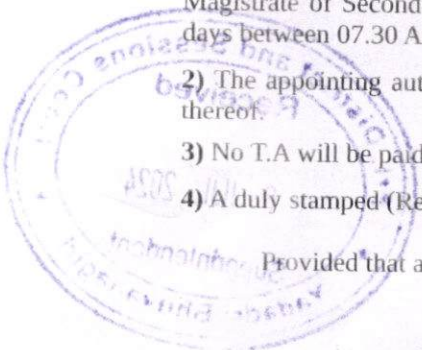
III. REVOCATION OF POWERS OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES

- 1) On appointment and while in service a Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class or Special Magistrate of any other category may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he/she fails to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suryapet as the case may be.
- 2) Powers conferred by the Court on Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class shall automatically stand withdrawn on his/her attaining the age of 65 years.

IV. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) As per the Hon'ble High Court Circular ROC.No. 802/SO/97, dated 29.01.1998 the Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class Courts function for (05) days in a week i.e., Monday to Friday working days between 07.30 AM and 10.30 AM.
- 2) The appointing authority reserves the right to cancel the notification without assigning any reason thereof.
- 3) No T.A will be paid for candidate for journey performed in connection with recruitment.
- 4) A duly stamped (Registered post) self addressed postal cover shall be enclosed.

Provided that a suitable Retired Judicial Officer shall be preferred.

I. ELIGIBILITY:

a) Must have **passed Intermediate Examination** conducted by A.P/ Telangana State Board of Intermediate Education or its equalent examination for the post of **Court Assistant**. Must have passed **7th class** examination for the post of **Court Attendant**.

b) Any retired person who held any post i.e Assistant, Examiner, Typist, Copyist and above in the Judicial Department is eligible for appointment of Court Assistant. Any retired person who held the post of Attender, Process Server or in any post in the last grade service in the Judicial Department is eligible for appointment of Court Attendant.

II. AGE:

- a) As on 01.07.2024 the candidates must not have completed (34) years and must have completed (18) years. The relaxation of maximum age limit is 5 years in respect of SC/ST and BC candidates and 10 years in respect of physically handicapped and Ex-Service Men.
- b) Any retired employee who crossed the age limit of 65 years shall not be eligible for the appointment of Court Assistant and Court Attendant.
