Applications (in Triplicate) are invited **up to 5-00 p. m. On 9.12.2024** in the prescribed format enclosed herewith, for appointment to the post of '**Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class at Nirmal**', from the eligible candidates for consideration. Applications received after due date will not be considered.

The intending eligible candidates shall submit their applications, along with attestation forms in triplicate.

The term of the post of '**Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class at Nirmal**' will be Two years from the date of assumption of charge. The term may be changed as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court. The selected candidate will be paid **honorarium of Rs.45,000/- (+) Rs.5,000/- (towards Conveyance Allowance) per month**, as per G.O.Ms.No.112, Finance (HRM.VII) Department, dated 13.3.2024 of the Government of Telangana.

RULES OF ELIGIBILITY SPECIFYING THE QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND DISQUALIFICATION, AS ENVISAGED IN HON'BLE HIGH COURT'S ROC NO.2589/95/E1, DATED: 29.3.1997

I. QUALIFICATIONS :

A PERSON

1. Who has held any post in Telangana Higher Judicial Services or State Judicial Services and retired or resign, OR
2. Who has held a post in the Telangana Judicial Ministerial Service not below the rank of Superintendent of District Court or Senior Civil Judge or Junior Civil Judge's Court and has a law degree : OR
3. Who has held a post of Section Officer and above in the Hon'ble Telangana High Court service and has a Law Degree, OR
4. A non-practicing Advocate with a practice at the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years of age **should file a Certificate of voluntary suspension of practice issued by the Bar Council of State of Telangana** : OR
5. Any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree OR who has passed the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of the Indian Penal Code; and the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of the Indian Penal Code Criminal Procedure) conducted by Telangana or Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial posers during his tenure or service for not less than three years.

And who has at least one year to complete 65 years of age at the date fixed by the Court in the year of recruitment shall alone be eligible.

Provided that a suitable retired Judicial Officer shall be preferred.

II. DISQUALIFICATIONS :

A PERSON

1. Who is a practicing Advocate, OR
2. Who is a Member of any State or Local Authority, OR
3. Who is a Member of the State Legislature or of the Parliament, OR
4. A person who having held an Office under the State or the Union Government or any Local Authority has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct, OR
5. A person who has been convicted and sentenced by the Court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged with any offence constituting moral turpitude and proceedings are pending, OR
6. A person of unsound mind or who is deaf or mute or blind or suffering from Leprosy or any other contagious disease; OR
7. A person adjudicated as an insolvent or an undischarged insolvent, OR
8. A contractor or a businessman or one interested in a subsisting contract or any work being done for Central or State Government or a Local Authority within whose limits the Special Magistrate has to discharge his duties shall not be eligible.

III. REVOCATION OF POWERS OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES :

1. On appointment and while in service a Special Magistrate of Second Class or Special Magistrate of any other category may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he fails to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate or the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, as the case may be.
2. Powers conferred by the Court on Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class or Special Magistrate of any other category shall automatically stand withdrawn on his attaining the age of 65 years.

IV. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS :

1. As per the Hon'ble High Court Circular ROC No.802/SO/97, dated 29.1.1998, the Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class Courts are functioning for (05) days in a week i. e. from Monday to Friday (on working days) between 7.30 AM to 10.30 AM.
2. The Appointing Authority reserves the right to cancel the Notification without assigning any reason thereof.
3. No T. A. will be paid to the candidate for the journey performed in connection with recruitment.
4. Applications shall be submitted in a sealed cover by superscribing the name of the Post on the cover and a duly stamped (for registered post) self addressed postal cover shall be enclosed.
5. Applications will not be received 'by hand' from the individuals and applications with insufficient information will be summarily rejected.
