i] Under the guidance of the District Judge there was discussion on provisions contained in section 41 of CrPC.-


“ When Police may arrest without warrant”.

Before arrest, first , the police officer should have “reason to believe” on the basis of information and material that the accused has committed the offence. Apart from this, the police officer has to be satisfied that the arrest is necessary for the purposes envisaged by sub-clauses (a) to (e) of clause (1) of Sec 41 Cr.PC.


The reasons/grounds are to be specified in the forwarding submitted by the police officer.

The reasons / grounds must satisfy test of reasonableness. No arrest can be made in a routine manner without reasonable satisfaction and a reasonable belief both as to the person’s complicity and even so as to the need to effect arrest.

The meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks


