**JUDGMENT**

**DATED: SEPTEMBER 12, 2025**

By means of present claim petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:

*“i. To issue an order or direction to the respondents to calculate, fix the pension of the petitioner and release the same in favour of the petitioner forthwith, along with interest @ 18% per annum on the arrears of the pension as accrued to the petitioner till the date of actual release.*

*ii. Issue any other or further direction which this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.*

*iii. To award the cost of the petition in favor of the petitioner.”*

2. The facts of the matter are that the petitioner has retired from service after attaining the age of superannuation on 31.12.2022. Since more than two and a half years period has elapsed from his date of retirement, but no pension has been released by the respondents. Learned Counsel for the petitioner prayed that he shall move a fresh representation to the respondent authorities, who may kindly be directed to decide the fresh representation of the petitioner, within a stipulated time. Learned A.P.O. has no objection to such innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, the Tribunal directs that the petitioner shall submit a fresh representation before the respondent authorities mentioning his grievances, along with certified copy of this order, within 15 days, who shall take suitable decision on the same within a period of one month thereafter.

4. With the above directions, the claim petition is disposed of, at the admission stage itself. No order as to costs.
