JUDGMENT

By means of present claim petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:

"i. To issue an order or direction to the respondents to calculate, fix the pension of the petitioner and release the same in favour of the petitioner forthwith, along with interest @ 18% per annum on the arrears of the pension as accrued to the petitioner till the

date of actual release.

ii. Issue any other or further direction which this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

iii. To award the cost of the petition in favor of the petitioner."

2. The facts of the matter are that the petitioner has retired from

service after attaining the age of superannuation on 31.12.2022. Since

more than two and a half years period has elapsed from his date of

retirement, but no pension has been released by the respondents.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner prayed that he shall move a fresh

representation to the respondent authorities, who may kindly be

directed to decide the fresh representation of the petitioner, within a

stipulated time. Learned A.P.O. has no objection to such innocuous

prayer of the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, the Tribunal directs that the petitioner

shall submit a fresh representation before the respondent authorities

mentioning his grievances, along with certified copy of this order,

within 15 days, who shall take suitable decision on the same within a

period of one month thereafter.

4. With the above directions, the claim petition is disposed of, at

the admission stage itself. No order as to costs.
