Ld. A.P.O. has filed compliance affidavit on behalf of respondents, in compliance of Tribunal's judgment dated 25.10.2024, passed in Claim Petition No. 31/DB/2023, Dr. Sanjeev Dutt vs. State of Uttarakhand and others. Operative portion of the judgment dated 25.10.2024 reads as under:

“The claim petition is, accordingly, disposed of by directing the respondent department to convene review DPC of the DPC dated 12.09.2014 and if the petitioner is found suitable, he should be given promotion, as per rules.”

Ld. A.P.O. has filed copy of promotion order of the petitioner dated 12.02.2025, issued by Sri Sachin Sharad C. Kurve, Secretary, Medical Health and Medical Education, Govt. of Uttarakhand, Dehradun, to show that the in compliance of Tribunal's order dated 25.10.2024, the review DPC of DPC dated 12.09.2014 was convened and on the recommendation of the DPC, the State Govt. vide its letter No. 370248 dated 12.02.2026 issued the notional promotion order of the petitioner on the post of Joint Director in the Pay Band-4 Rs.37400-67000 with grade pay Rs.8700/- w.e.f. 12.04.2013, on

which date his immediate junior Dr. Sambhu Kumar Jha was promoted to the post of Joint Director. Thus the respondent department has complied with the directions issued by the Tribunal.

Sri L.K.Maithani, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner/applicant submitted that petitioner is satisfied with the same.

When the order of the Tribunal has been complied with, the contempt petition is closed for full satisfaction.
