JUDGMENT

DATED: AUGUST 06, 2026

By means of present claim petition, petitioner seeks the following reliefs:

- “(I) To direct the respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 17-07-2025 (Annexure No. A-1 Colly)
- (II) To pass any other order the Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit.
- (III) Award the cost of the petition to the petitioner.”

2. Facts of the claim petition, in brief are that, the petitioner was appointed as Driver on 28.02.2006 in the office of Assistant Labour Commissioner, Haridwar. Thereafter, by transfer order dated 14.07.2011, he was transferred from the office of the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Haridwar to the office of the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Rishikesh, where he has been continuously serving since the date of his transfer. His salary was transferred from the Dehradun office to the Haridwar office without any transfer order due to which he has not been sanctioned financial benefit due to staff of Dehradun.

3. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has filed representation on 17.07.2025 before the Labour Commissioner, Haldwani, raising his grievances, which has not been decided so far.

4. The sole prayer of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner is that a direction may kindly be given to the authority concerned to decide the pending representation of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a stipulated period.

5. Ld. A.P.O, has no objection to such innocuous prayer of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, if a direction is given to the authority concerned to decide the representation of the petitioner, as per rules.

6. In view of the above, Respondent No.2, is hereby directed to decide the pending representation of the petitioner dated 17.07.2025 (Annexure: A-1), by a reasoned and speaking order, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, but not later than four weeks of presentation of certified copy of this order.

7. The claim petition is disposed of, accordingly, at the admission stage.
