During the course of hearing, on the point of admission, it transpired that the departmental authority has not issued final seniority list in compliance of Tribunal's judgment dated 14.11.2025 passed in Claim Petition No. 116/DB/2024, Sri Amit Singh Rawat and others vs. State of Uttarakhand and others.

Relevant paragraphs of the judgment read as under:

“13. In substance, the impugned seniority list dated 18.08.2023 (Annexure-1) cannot sustain *qua* petitioners only, inasmuch as no notice was given to them before changing their seniority to their detriment.

14. Seniority list dated 18.08.2023 (Annexure-1) is, therefore, set aside only in respect of the petitioners. Respondent Corporation is directed to afford reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioners before placing them appropriately in the final seniority list. The same shall be done as expeditiously as possible, without unreasonable delay.”

Tribunal is of the view that, in the circumstances, there is no necessity for filing a separate claim petition, and the appropriate remedy would be to seek execution/compliance of the aforesaid judgment.

In view of the above, the claim petition is premature and against the order of the Tribunal dated 14.11.2025.

The claim petition is, accordingly, dismissed at the admission stage, as premature.
