### Item No.113.6: Repair and renovation of water proofing works for the Girls' Hostel roof:

The additional fund required to meet the said expenses shall be met from the GIA of CRCSRE.

The Executive Council instructed Director, SVNIRTAR to reformulate the proposal and resubmit in the next EC subject to the following conditions:

- (ii) Explore the requirement/availability of posts which can be offered to Smt. M. Sunitha, widow of Shri Pavan Kumar, Vocational Instructor, CRCSRE, Guwahati on outsourced basis against the sanctioned strength.
- Item No.113.15: Compulsory Retirement from Service of Mr. Laxmidhar Mallick, MTS, SVNIRTAR and Termination from service of Mrs. Mandakini Lenka, Store Keeper, SVNIRTAR:

The Executive Council was appraised and took a note of it.

Item No.113.16: Engagement of Attendant for Early Intervention Centre (EIC) and Patients Mess:

Considering the requirements, the Executive Council considered and approved for engagement of three unskilled labours (01 Male and 01 Female for EIC & 01 Male for Patients Mess) of SVNIRTAR on outsourced basis under minimum wages act of Government of India.
