Item No.40.1: Confirmation of Minutes of 39th General Council meeting held on 28th February 2022:

The General Council confirmed the Minutes of 39th General Council meeting held on 28th February, 2022 at 12:00 Noon through Video Conferencing.

Item No.40.2: Action Taken Report (Follow-up Action):

The General Council noted the Action Taken against the 39th General Council held on 28th February 2022 with the following observations:

- i. Proposal for resolving network issues for joining and attending meeting on video conferencing: The proposal was placed before 117th Executive Council meeting held on 23rd May 2022. The Executive Council approved the proposal for resolving network issues with 100 Mbps Leased Internet Speed for joining and attending meeting on video conferencing at SVNIRTAR with following norms:
 - To explore the facility in Gem failing which e-tender
 - No vender name should be specified in the tender documents.
- ii. After handing over the 100 bedded Annexe Building under CSR Assistance the mode of operandi, plan of action operationalization and staffing pattern is placed at Separate Agenda for kind consideration and approval of General Council.
- iii. As per directives of General Council, the 02nd General Council meeting held on 03rd June 2022.
- iv. Mode of operandi, plan of action, operationalization and staffing pattern of the Vocational Training Building funded by SIPDA is placed at Separate Agenda for kind consideration and approval of General Council.

Item No.40.3: Proposal for resolving network issues for joining and attending meeting on Video conferencing:

The 117th Executive Council held on 23rd May 2022 approved the proposal for resolving network issues with 100 Mbps Leased Internet Speed for joining and attending meeting on video conferencing at SVNIRTAR appears to be on the lower side and this needs to be revised upwardly and since the no. of operators are very limited, it will be difficult to find out the vendor, so the organization may come out with tenders. The necessary process to be adopted.
