1. Introduction

Swami Vivekanand National Institute of Rehabilitation Training and Research (SVNIRTAR) is an Autonomous body under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India. The Dept of PMR of the institute started in 1987 providing comprehensive rehabilitation services along with State of Art therapeutic and prosthetic & Orthotic services. The department of PMR known for its excellence in Rehabilitation Surgery, has 2 modular operation theatres which run 4 days a week and 200 indoor bed capacity. The Department is accredited with NBE for conducting DNB in the specialty of PMR.

The subject of PMR is very vast having multiple dimensions. To enhance clinical competency among postgraduates and young physiatrists, starting short-term fellowships in different dimensions of PMR is the need of the hour. Persons with disabilities during their rehabilitation management often require some short Rehabilitation surgery which is usually neglected by other related surgical specialties. The poor PWD has to run from pillar to post for their surgical management. A basic knowledge of Rehabilitation surgery can increase the competence of a Physiatrist and strengthen his rehabilitation practice.

2. Program Goal & Objectives:

To train young physiatrists with quality knowledge and skills to adopt the principles and practice of Rehabilitation Surgery and to provide surgical Rehabilitation interventions of a high standard in an ethical manner as expected under different clinical settings. The person trained should be able to clinically assess, investigate, diagnose, prognosticate, and perform rehabilitation surgery. On completion, the physiatrist should attain an understanding of and develop competence in executing common general Rehabilitation surgical procedures related to the specialty of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

3. Eligibility and Selection Method

- a. Must be a qualified Physiatrist (MD/DNB in PMR) with a valid registration certificate
- b. Must be less than 45 years of age
- c. Selection will be by interview along with career marking

4. Duration of the Course: 06 months

5. Number of seats: 02

6. Stipend: For Direct candidates: 50, 000/- per month

For sponsored candidates: No stipend

7. Application procedure:

Interested Candidate has to apply offline in the prescribed format along with the documents as follows:

- a. Matriculation Board Certificate for confirmation of name & age
- b. Bachelor's Degree: MBBS certificate
- c. MD/ DNB certificate of PMR
- d. Marksheet
- e. Medical Council registration certificate
- f. Letter of forwarding from the appropriate authority for sponsor candidates

- **8. Admission Fees**: 20,000/-
- **9. Caution money**: 10,000/-(Will be refunded at the end of the course)
- 10. The Penalty for discontinuation of the course: 50,000/- or One month stipend would be deducted
- 11. Declaration by the candidate: To abide by the rules and regulations of the institute
- 12. Methods of Training and Teaching

The training program would focus on knowledge, skills, and all essential components of rehabilitation surgery. The candidate has to attend OPD for evaluation of cases that require admission for surgery. Clinical, radiological evaluation, and treatment planning would be discussed and presented by the candidate before posting the cases in OT for surgery. The fellow would be provided with an opportunity to learn, assist, and perform operations commonly required for the rehabilitation of persons with disability, including post-operative care under the direct supervision of a PMR faculty member.

- a. Clinical evaluation of Hip, Knee, Foot and ankle, shoulder, elbow, hand & wrist
- b. Clinical evaluation of the spine
- c. Radiological evaluation of deformities
- d. Surgical approaches
- e. Tourniquate, antiseptics, electrocoagulation
- f. Patient Positioning on OT
- g. Instruments and Implants used in rehabilitation surgery
- h. Surgical sutures
- i. Dos and Don't in Operation Theatre

- 21. External fixator Ilizarov
- 22. Corrective osteotomies
- 23. Growth modulation Minimal invasive deformity correction
