Item No.138.1: Confirmation of Minutes of 136th Executive Council and 137th Special Executive Council held on 20th November 2025 and 15th December 2025 through Hybrid Mode at SVNIRTAR, Cuttack and Virtual Mode respectively:

The Executive Council confirmed the minutes of 136th Executive Council and 137th Special Executive Council held on 20th November 2025 and 15th December 2025 through Hybrid Mode at SVNIRTAR, Cuttack and Virtual Mode respectively considering no objection/comments after circulation of the Minutes.

Item No.138.2: Action Taken Report (Follow-up Action):

The Executive Council noted the action taken on the Minutes of 136th Executive Council and 137th Special Executive Council held on 20th November 2025 and 15th December 2025 through Hybrid Mode at SVNIRTAR, Cuttack and Virtual Mode respectively.

Item No.138.3: Enhancement of stipend for the fellows joining the Rehabilitation Surgery Fellowship:

After elaborate discussion the Executive Council considered and approved the proposal of enhancement of the consolidated stipend to ₹75,000/- (Rupees Seventy-Five Thousand) per month per fellow of the Rehabilitation Surgery Fellowship Course.
