Scope of work

Opinion regarding two separate sub agreements w.r.t. RFP, LoA, MOU & other documents.

1. Original current members of the Concessionaire Agreement, is as under:

- Sumeet Facilities Limited -- 29%
- SSG Transporte Sanitario, S.L., Spain -- 26%
- BVG India Limited -- 45%
- SPV propose two separate agreements to be executed with the below entities:
- Sumeet SSG Maharashtra EMS Pvt Ltd -- 55%
- BVG India Ltd -- 45%

2. Accordingly, in view of the above subject, SPV proposed following two separate agreements

a) A separate agreement between CHS and Sumeet SSG Maharashtra EMS Private Limited, being a legal entity representing Sumeet Facilities Limited and SSG Transporte Sanitario, S.L., Spain, for the 55% of the total scope of supply and services under the Project.

b) A separate agreement between CHS and BVG India Limited for 45% of the total scope of supply and services under the Project;

4. Award of Contract:

The purchaser will award the contract to the bidder whose quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated quotation price. The total amount quoted by the bidder will be on the basis for evaluation.

4.1) Notwithstanding the above, the Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract.

4.2) The bidder whose quotation is accepted will be notified about the award of contract by the purchaser prior to expiration of the quotation validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the purchase order.

5. Liquidated Damages:

Liquidity damages at the rate of 0.5% per week for the delay in services subject to maximum of 10% computed on the value of goods supplied delayed.
