

## Meeting of the NIC HP State Coordinator with All DIOs/ADIOs / Group Heads Through VC on 13-December-2021 from 12:00 Noon to 2:00 PM

Smt. Rachna Srivastava, State Coordinator of NIC Himachal Pradesh, interacted with SIO, ASIO, Group Heads at Shimla, NIC Centre In-charges, DIOs/ ADIOs through Video Conference on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2021. She appreciated the work done by NIC Himachal Pradesh.



Sh. Ajay Singh Chahal, SIO welcomed the NIC HP State Coordinator. He presented the activities carried out by NIC HP during the last 5 months. He started with updations on points flagged by the State Coordinator in the last meeting. Thereafter, the SIO informed about the following major activities which were carried out by NIC HP:

1. **Oxycare:** It was informed that after successful development of Covid19cc application NIC HP was assigned task of development of pan India application oxycare. Initially scope of the project was to monitor the supply of one lakh Oxygen Concentrators (OCs). Later, the scope was revised to include monitoring of PSA (Pressure Swing Adsorption) Oxygen Plants being installed at various government hospitals in the country, with IOT based online monitoring. The scope has again been revised to include monitoring of the supply of ventilators and OCCs throughout the country.
2. **PM's VCs:** NIC HP Successfully conducted VCs of Hon'able Prime Minister of India. Sh. Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, interacted with the beneficiaries and Health officials of Himachal Pradesh on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021 on achieving the 100 % target of Covid19 vaccine vaccination. Sh. Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, virtually inaugurated All India Presiding Officers Conference (AIPOC) held at HP Vidhan Sabha On 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2021

3. **HPAPPP (HP Agriculture Produce Procurement Portal):** NIC Himachal Pradesh was assigned the task of Development of portal for procurement of agricultural produce of farmers of Himachal Pradesh on MSP. The development was successfully completed within very short time.
4. **Mobile Application Development Framework:** Comprehensive document has been prepared and eBook is likely to be released for use by NIC officers at all levels for quickly developing mobile applications due to the wide-spread usage.

The State Coordinator congratulated NIC HP for successful development of OxyCare and HPAPPP applications. As regards PMs VCs, she was of the opinion that VC is strength of NIC and one of the most effective infrastructures created by NIC. She desired to have detailed demonstration on OxyCare and HPAPPP application. She appreciated the work done by NIC HP despite shortage of manpower. The State Coordinator suggested that the state should create a pool of hired resources and shuffle them in different projects.



**The common activities reported by DIOs and ADIOs were:**

- Status of implementation of eHimbhoomi
- Status of Implementation of NGDRS
- Status of Implementation of iRAD
- Support provided during bye elections
- Status of District Digital Repository Project.
- DIO Mandi informed that SMIS Application has been updated and eRoznamcha is being replicated in Chamba and Una District.
- DIO Kangra, updated about the new features implemented under Vahan & Saarathi Applications and also updated about iRAD project. It was suggested that in eOffice there should be option to load scanned signatures which should be printed on letters instead of loading scanned signed documents.
- DIO Shimla, updated about IVFRT, ICJS and ALIS.
- DIO Solan, informed that eKayan Mobile App developed under DGMC has been updated with new features and Audit has been completed for the same.
- DIO Kullu and Chamba informed that that the bandwidth has been upgraded to 100 Mbps.

- Various trainings conducted for different departments.

The State Coordinator was of the opinion that the development at the district level should be generic in nature with scope of replication in other districts. DIOs should not repeat the effort and replicate the applications developed by other DIOs. It was suggested that there should be district level suite of applications required at District level. The suite should have common code base and all the DIOs should collaborate and do collective development.



The **Main activities** reported by Group Heads and Other Officers posted in various other offices are:

- **Sh. Neeraj Goel, STD** informed about a document prepared regarding Mid Carrier Training Program for NIC Officers. The State coordinator suggested that there should be regular training on eOffice as it is being replicated in many offices.
- **Sh. Ashwani Kumar, In-charge High Court**, it was informed that New Chief Justice has joined in HP High Court. The Chief Justice interacted with SIO Himachal Pradesh and desired for few tasks to be completed on top priority. These tasks include pagination during eFiling, virtual court for Shimla, mobile app revision, MEDLEAPAR implementation.
- **Sh. Vimal Kumar Sharma, TD & DDO** updated on the GeM related activity and Applications being taken up under Service Plus.
- **Sh. Shailender Kaushal, TD** informed about support provided for Kawach Implementation. It was informed that there was issue related to creation of eMail accounts for board and

corporations; the same has been resolved in collaboration with DIT. He updated on the work being done on Micro-services/ containers.

- **Sh. Sanjay Sharma, STD** and Group Head informed about setting up of New ICT infrastructure for Oxycare application. He discussed about Departmental Examination application and Audit related activities.
- **Sh. Sandeep Sood, STD** updated about the HPAPPP Portal, Oxycare mobile Apps and mHimbhoomi.
- **Sh. Lalit Kapoor, STD** updated about the implementation of NGDRS and HimAtithi Application.
- **Sh. Sanjay Thakur, TD** updated about HPPSC, HPRERA, Works MIS, HPSDMA applications.
- **Sh. Vijay Gupta, STD** updated about HPAPPP, Oxycare, eGranthalaya, eHospital IFMS and PFMS. He informed that the New Chief Justice has agreed to use eSalary software for preparation of salary for judges. It has been implemented.



The **Decisions** taken in the meeting are:

1. OxyCare features demonstration to State Coordinator
2. CPGRAM Mobile App with Multilingual features, to be enriched with new features
3. District Suite for HP State to be explored by clubbing together District developed SW
4. Generic solutions for online appointments in NIC applications, as a feature
5. Mid Carrier training program for NIC Officers, proposal to be forwarded to Training Division.
6. NIC HP at a Glance- Excel sheet to be modified to list of projects with ranking etc.

The SIO thanked the State Coordinator for all the support and blessings.
