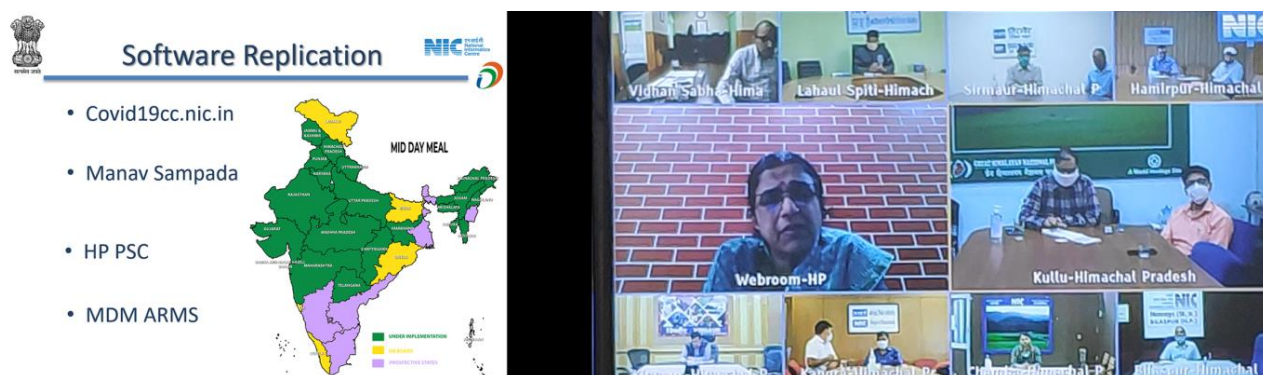


Meeting of the NIC HP State Coordinator with DIOs/ADIOs/ Group Heads Through VC on 22-September-2020 from 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM

Smt. Padmavathi Viswanathan, DDG and NIC HP State Coordinator interacted with SIO, ASIO, Group Head, NIC Centre In-charges, DIOs/ ADIOs through Video Conference on 22nd September, 2020 from 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM. She reviewed the work done during June-September, 2020 and inquired the health and welfare of officials, including the difficulties faced, if any during the ongoing Covid19 pandemic. The Group Heads/ NIC HP officers were at Shimla and remaining DIOs and ADIOs participated from their respective locations. The list of participating officers is given on Page-7 and all officers gave details of work done by them during June-September 2020.



Sh. Ajay Singh Chahal, SIO NIC HP, welcomed the NIC HP State Coordinator, Smt. Padmavathi Viswanathan on behalf of NIC officers from State Center, Districts and other offices and thanked her concern about welfare of NIC HP officials and regularly interacting with NIC HP officers. The SIO thanked her for her support and guidance to NIC Himachal Pradesh. SIO informed that as per State Coordinators advice, strict care is being taken during these COVID times, all the officers are wearing masks and care is being taken to regularly sanitize the work area.

With the permission of State Coordinator, the SIO presented the activities being carried out, through a Presentation covering the following work-areas:

Software Replication:

- RT-PCR app and <https://coivd19cc.nic.in> portal has been replicated Pan India. All the states except Andhra and Bihar are on board. He informed that till date data related to around 3.7 Crore samples have been collected using RT-PCR app and daily collection has reached a mark of 5 Lakh samples.
- The Manav Sampada software has been replicated in 19 States and 4 more States are expected to join soon.
- MDM has also been replicated in 18 States.
- Implementation of HPPSC software has been started in HP and demo has been held for 4 States and is expected to be rolled out by March 2021.

The State Coordinator informed that Lab is being established at Delhi on mobile apps and as Himachal Pradesh is leading State in mobile development, it is proposed to have interaction with NIC HP Mobile team, on a date/time to be conveyed later.

It was informed by the SIO that all Audit paras of last external audit have been cleared. He informed that in HP all employee/vendor bills are cleared in same month and there is no pendency. He informed that as discussed during last meeting, all the districts have been provided with new chairs and District have utilized the funds allotted to them for Covid19 containment.

The State coordinator highly appreciated the work activities being done by NIC HP even at national level.



Thereafter, the State Coordinator interacted with all the Officers of NIC Himachal Pradesh, starting with the Districts. During the interaction she was enquired about status of health of each and every officer and their family members. She also pointed out that during these testing times all the officers should take care of their health and family by taking all necessary precautions. All officers present in the VC based meeting highlighted their work activities.

DIOs/ ADIOs updated on the activities carried out at their respective districts. The common activities were:

1. Extensive use of Video conferencing at different level. VC was used for inaugurations also.
2. PM Kisaan data mapping with Land Records: all the DIOs updated on the status of mapping. Una informed that mapping has been completed.
3. Web based eKalyan testing.
4. Trainings on implementation of NGDRS
5. Shifting of data to eHimbhoomi.
6. Circle rates updations/ notifications for current financial year.
7. Trainings
8. Regular website updations.

DIO Kangra informed that faceless transactions have been started where by most of the activities related to Transport Department have been made online.

DIO Mandi informed that Roznamcha software has launched in Mandi district, the software has been developed using Open source technologies (Django, Python and Postgre Sql). Very soon it will be replicated in all the Districts.

District Kullu & Lahaul Spiti informed that they are involved in the preparations for PMs Visit.

DIO Solan raised issue of stand by UPS for the districts to which the State Coordinator informed that they have already put up a policy note for the same.

After districts the State Coordinator interacted with officers posted at different offices in Shimla.

HIPA: Sh. Neeraj Goel, STD updated about the training activities being carried out at HIPA. He informed that trainings are being imparted online and regularly webinars are also being conducted.

HP Vidhan Sabha: Sh. Dharmesh Sharma, STD informed that Virtual connectivity was provided to Corona Positive members during last Vidhan Sabha session. 28 workshops were held on e-Constituency for different levels. MC Shimla has already released funds for replication of eVidhan. He also informed about the process initiated for copyright of eVidhan 3.0.

HP High Court: Sh. Ashwani Kumar, PSA, informed that Virtual Courts Software has been tested and training has been imparted and will be launched soon. ICJS has been tested with Police Department.

CGO: Sh. Sanjay Kumar, STD updated about MDM, HPPSC, Manav Sampada and Covid19CC portal. He added that Medical Bills/ LTC/ TA facilities are being added in Manav Sampada. He informed that HPRERA, HP SDMA, Revenue Relief for Outsees, Online Teachers Transfer policy

and Cooperation MIS are some of the new projects which have been developed/ under development. Online Teachers Transfer Policy software was demonstrated in the Cabinet also. He informed that they are working on new technologies like Micro Services Architecture, Node JS, Flutter etc.



Thereafter State Coordinator interacted with Group Heads/ Officers posted at NIC HP State Center.

Sh. Shailender Kaushal, TD, informed that during the period he conducted lots of VCs using webex. Web based VPN accounts were created for state users. Around 30 NEW VMs were allocated and applications are being shifted to cloud. Link of DHQ Shimla was upgraded to 100 Mbps. Proposal for CCTV Cameras have been initiated.

Sh. Sanjay Sharma, STD talked about HPPSC software and Covid19cc Infrastructure. He informed that new infrastructure is being created for Covid19cc as presently SQL Server evaluation version is being used which is expiring soon. He also talked about Security audit and web coordination activities. He added that he is also involved in preparation of short movies related to NIC HP and different projects.

Sh. Sandeep Sood, STD talked about the support being provided for RT-PCR and RATI. He also updated about Himpragati where VIP references and calendar of events is being added, eSamadhan has been integrated with CM Refnic and training has been provided, process is on for integrating eSamadhan with CP Gram and also development of Data Profiler for State Election Commission is in progress.

Sh. Lalit Kapoor, STD updated that data is being shifted to web based eKalyan for all the districts and next quarter of social security pensions will be generated through web based software. He informed that process has been initiated for replication of NGDRS in the State.

Sh. Vijay Gupta, TD informed that two software namely BPL Families MIS and Pong Dam Outsees Software have been developed in Open Source. Work on Common Random Inspections software for Industries is in progress. Micro Services Architecture is being used for eSalary with Manav Sampada. Work is in progress for eChallan and POS integration, Integration with eKuber and MLAs Salary using eSalary software.

During the discussions the State Coordinator asked if Analytics is being done as lots of data is getting generated in the NIC HP developed software. The SIO replied that we have been doing it inhouse as evident in Covid19 portal but tools require funds. The State Coordinator inquired about the status of old hardware/ furniture etc and she was informed that it has been declared obsolete and auctioned too. She desired to carry out similar exercise with office record too in time bound manner.

Sh. Praveen Sharma, Scientist-B raised the issue of new Review policy to which the State Coordinator updated the matter has been taken up but final decision is with the Ministry.

The State Coordinator appreciated the work being done by all NIC HP officer as an excellent team and gave following suggestions:

1. Weeding out of obsolete record, advice to be sought from Sh. P.K. Upadhyay, Sr. TD, on records pertaining to old DSCs available at NIC HP earlier than 7 years
2. Getting software quality audit done through SQG for important products like HP PSS SW
3. Procurement of Oxymeter and Thermanl Scanners for NIC officials in all offices
4. She also assured to follow up the action being taken in the matter of procurement of physical security equipment and 20 KVA UPS at NIC Hqrs.



The meeting ended with a vote of thanks.
